Terms and Conditions

- Your approved waste management plan must be kept on the jobsite in the permit folder for the duration of the project.
- City staff may enter the jobsite to inspect waste collection areas for transport, reuse, or recycle.
- Only the certified C&D El Dorado Disposal Service sorting facilities may be used to sort recyclable material if debris is mixed on job site and not self hauled.
- These waste materials will be protected from hazardous materials that may keep them from being recycled properly.
- Construction, deconstruction and demolition debris may not be burned or dumped illegally.
- The **Actual Waste Material Disposal/Diversion Worksheet** generated must be completed and submitted before or at final inspection.
- Include receipts or weight tickets with submitted Waste Worksheet.
- Salvage: Excess materials that cannot be used in the project, nor returned to the vendor, will be offered to site workers, the owner(s), or donated to charity if feasible.
- Failure to comply with these terms and conditions may result in further requirements and corrections.

Responsibilities and Acknowledgement

This *Waste Management Plan* and supporting documents must be submitted and approved before permit issuance.

Include receipts from the El Dorado Disposal Services which collected or received the materials showing the actual weight, weight slips/count of materials salvaged, or volume of the materials (recyclables and solid waste). Attach to the Actual Material Disposal/Diversion Worksheet.

Include an attachment for approval if you believe that your project is entitled to an exemption and should not be required to divert or recycle construction, deconstruction or demolition debris.
