CONSTRUCTION UPDATE #4

Hi Everyone!

- ▶ This is a periodic update to the community regarding the construction of the Blairs Lane Bridge Replacement Project. These updates will be issued via email to interested parties and will be posted on the City of Placerville website.

Work Updates

- ▶ The old one lane bridge on Blairs Lane has been removed!
- ▶ Excavation for the new bridge footings has begun and is expected to be complete by the end of this week! That means construction of the new 2-lane bridge will be in full construction mode next week.
- ▶ The new sewer construction along Broadway with all sewer lateral tie-ins has been complete. The contractor will be doing the **final paving** of the trench sections on Broadway beginning tomorrow and in to Friday!
- ▶ ***Please be prepared for 2-full days (Thursday and Friday) this week for traffic on Broadway to be impacted, take an alternate route if possible.*** This means there will be traffic controlled to 1-lane on Broadway through the construction zone from Wells Fargo east to the Broadway Plaza. Access to all businesses will remain open during this work.
- ▶ Retaining wall construction on the south side of the bridge continues. The retaining walls on the PG&E substation side will begin next week.
- ▶ Next week, please be prepared for work on Broadway from Blairs Lane to the Broadway Plaza. Work will begin on replacing one of the City's sewer mains identified by the Public Works department as being compromised. *Please expect traffic control around this area for the entire week of 8/1-8/5.*

Please talk with the construction inspectors from UNICO Engineer or contact the City directly, to address time-sensitive issues that arise.
