



**A Proclamation of the City Council of the City of Placerville
Declaring November 1, 2014 as Extra Mile Day in the City of Placerville
and Commending Past President Paul Zappettini and the
Kiwanis Club of Placerville For "Going the Extra Mile"**

- Whereas:** The City of Placerville is a community that acknowledges that a special vibrancy exists within the entire community when its individual citizens collectively "go the extra mile" in personal effort, volunteerism, and service; and
- Whereas:** Placerville is a community that encourages its citizens to maximize their personal contribution to the community by giving of themselves wholeheartedly and with total effort, commitment, and conviction to their individual ambitions, family, friends, and community; and
- Whereas:** Placerville acknowledges the mission of the Extra Mile America Foundation to create 500 Extra Mile cities in America and is proud to support "Extra Mile Day," on November 1, 2014; and
- Whereas:** Placerville chooses to shine a light on and celebrate individuals and organizations within our community who "go the extra mile", in order to make a difference and lift up fellow members of their community; and
- Whereas:** Kiwanis Club of Placerville Past President, Paul Zappettini, and the Kiwanis Club, Key Clubs from El Dorado High School, Ponderosa High School, and Union Mine High School, Markham Middle School Builder's Club and the Aktion Club for adults with disabilities, have gone the Extra Mile and are recognized as the 2014 Extra Mile America recipients; and
