33rd ANNUAL NATIONAL NIGHT OUT

Placerville, CA – The City of Placerville is ranked first for California and fourth in the United States for this summer’s National Night Out event.

National Night Out (NNO) has announced its’ award winners and Placerville is once again at the top! The City of Placerville is first in the state and fourth overall in the nation for cities with a population under 15,000. The National Association of Town Watch (NATW) reviews applications from all over the nation and this year’s National Night Out campaign involved 38.5 million neighbors and over 16,000 communities across the United States.

There were 19 NNO parties across the City of Placerville on August 2, 2016, including four large parties at Grocery Outlet, the county library, Benham Park and our kickoff event at M.O.R.E. In addition to the one day National Night Out event, the Placerville Police Department submitted the substation as “Project 365” to NATW. A scrapbook with all the pictures from the parties and events leading up to NNO was completed and submitted with our video to NATW for the award process.
