

**RESOLUTION NO. 7842**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE  
AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO  
CALIFORNIA PAVEMENT MAINTENANCE COMPANY, INC. FOR THE  
EL DORADO SLURRY SEAL PROJECT (CIP#40805).**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Placerville received funding through the El Dorado County Transportation Commission, Transportation Development Act, Article 3; Pedestrian and Bicycle Account, in the amount of \$49,500 for resurfacing of the El Dorado Trail from Mosquito Road to Jacquier Road (EDCTC Resolution 07/08.02); and,

**WHEREAS**, City engineering Staff have prepared plans and specifications for construction of said improvements and solicited bids for which two responsive and responsible bids were received, opened and read aloud on August 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2010; and,

**WHEREAS**, California Pavement Maintenance Inc., provided the lowest responsive and responsible bid in the amount of \$61,801; and,

**WHEREAS**, California Pavement Maintenance Company, Inc. has been determined to possess the appropriate licenses, certifications, insurance, and bonding to construct the project; and,

**WHEREAS**, there are no bid irregularities or a bid protest; and,

**WHEREAS**, the low bid amount is greater than the funds available therefore the scope of work will need to be adjusted as necessary, pursuant to the Section 4-1.05 of the Contract Special Provisions, "Adjustments to Scope of Work and Contract Price", by way of contract change order.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council of the City of Placerville does hereby:

1. Award a construction contract with California Pavement Maintenance Company, Inc. for the El Dorado Trail Slurry Seal Project (CIP #40805), from Mosquito Road to Jacquier Road, in the amount of \$61,801.00, and authorize the City Manager to execute said contract; and,
2. Approve a \$27,900 budget appropriation from the Article 3 Fund for the El Dorado Trail Repair and Resurfacing project (CIP #40805); and
3. Authorize the Public Works Director to execute a contract change order with California Pavement Maintenance Company, Inc. to adjust the scope of work reducing the final contract to an amount not to exceed the \$49,500 budget appropriation.

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The foregoing Resolution was introduced at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Placerville held on September 28<sup>th</sup>, 2010 by Councilmember \_\_\_\_\_, who moved its adoption.
