# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE DESIGNATING THE METHODIST EPISCOPAL CHURCH AS A HISTORIC BUILDING

WHEREAS, the Methodist-Episcopal Church building was constructed in 1851 on a side of a hill above Cedar Ravine near Main Street on the southeast corner of this intersection; and

WHEREAS, sometime after, a brick church was built in 1865 or 1866 at ground level, and the original church was placed on top of and became a second story to the building which sat next to the brick Methodist Church at the corner; and

WHEREAS, the building served as the residence for the pastor and for other church uses; and

WHEREAS, when the El Dorado County Federated Church built their new facility in the present location on Thompson Way and sold the site of the brick church the site was cleared; and

WHEREAS, the 1851 church structure was dismantled and the materials were saved; and

WHEREAS, in 1961 the El Dorado County Historic Society, the members of the El Dorado County Federated Church, and the El Dorado County Chamber of Commerce dedicated the reconstructed church building and designated it a point of interest at its present location on Thompson Way on the properties of the El Dorado County Federated Church; and

WHEREAS, the City of Placerville has received a letter from Marilyn Mills, Chairperson of the Historic Committee of the El Dorado County Federated Church requesting that the City of Placerville designate the church as a historic structure;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Placerville does hereby designate the Methodist-Episcopal Church building on its present location on the properties of the El

Dorado County Federated Church on Thompson Way as a historic structure.

The foregoing Resolution was introduced at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Placerville held on April 28, 1992 by Councilmember Borelli , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Tustin . Carried and so ordered.
