RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF PLACERVILLE
DESIGNATING CITY CEMETERY AS A HISTORIC SITE

WHEREAS, the City of Placerville owns and maintains the
City Cemetery on Chamberlin Street; and,

WHEREAS, this cemetery contains much of the rich history
of the people who originally settled in the Placerville area; and

WHEREAS, the Placerville Cemetery Preservation Committee
was formed to continue the planning, development and preservation
of the cemetery for the public; and

WHEREAS, the Placerville Cemetery Preservation Committee
desires to establish the City Cemetery as a Historical Site; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Placerville wishes
to promote and preserve the history of our community,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the
City Council of the City of Placerville designates City Cemetery
a Historic Site.

The foregoing Resolution was introduced at a regular meeting
of the City Council of the City of Placerville held on March 8,
1983, by Councilmember Sullivan, who moved its
adoption. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Borelli.
