SUBJECT: **AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR THE 2009 /2010 ANNUAL STREET STRIPING PROGRAM, PROJECT NO. 41003 AND AUTHORIZE EXECUTION OF SAID CONTRACT AND NOTICE TO PROCEED**

RECOMMENDATION:

That City Council adopt a resolution:

1. Awarding the contract for the 2009/ 2010 Annual Street Striping Program in the amount of \$23,918.90 to Traffic Limited.
2. Authorize the City Manager to execute said contract and Notice to Proceed.

BACKGROUND:

As outlined in the 09/10 Fiscal Year Budget, this project is part of an annual program which consists of the placement of new painted roadway striping to renew the existing faded striping to improve visibility and roadway safety.

DISCUSSION:

The proposed contract is to repaint the existing striping, including edge line and turn pockets on City roadways. Attached is a list of the roads that will receive striping as part of this contract. Approximately 32 miles of pavement striping will be placed as part of this agreement.

An informal request for proposals was given to local striping contractors and the local builder's exchange. Two bids were received as follows:

Traffic Limited was determined to be the apparent low bidder. Engineering has reviewed the proposal and found no irregularities, and no bid protests were filed. Staff finds Traffic Limited to be a responsive and responsible bidder based on past experience while working with them on previous street striping tasks performed within the City. The work is anticipated to take approximately one month to complete. The Contractor will be provided with a Notice to Proceed immediately upon execution of the contract in order to allow the striping to be in place prior to the onset of the fall and winter seasons.

FISCAL IMPACT

The City Council adopted the 2009/2010 Fiscal Year Capital Improvement Program Budget which appropriated \$25,000 for the Annual Street Striping project (CIP #41003). The proposed agreement with Traffic Limited is \$23,919 which is well within the \$25,000 project budget. Tonight, staff respectfully requests that Council award the proposed agreement with Traffic Limited and authorize the City Manager to execute same.
