CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Week #20: February 13th – 17th

Hi Everyone!

This is a weekly update to the community regarding the Pardi Way/Big Cut Rd./Sacramento Street Waterline Replacement Project. Construction began Monday, October 3rd, and these updates will be sent via email to interested parties and posted on the City of Placerville's website to keep the community informed as to the status of this project. Each update will involve a summary of work completed the prior week, work being performed the current week, work anticipated the following week, and any important information that may impact the community. Thanks in advance for everyone's understanding and patience through this process.

Prior Week

- No work was performed due to the weather.

Current Week

- **Day Work:** The contractor will attempt to perform any repair work and potholing during the day but work on Sacramento Street requires night work due to the vehicle traffic.
- **Night Work (Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday):** The contractor will be performing further system testing during the evenings this week to continue to evaluate if there are any leaks needing to be repaired prior to the pressure test. **Sacramento Street will be closed during this work.**

Following Week

- **Day Work:** Day work next week is pending further evaluation of the system and is weather dependent. The contractor will attempt to perform any repair work and potholing during the day.
- **Night Work:** The contractor may perform further system testing during the evenings next week to continue to evaluate if there are any leaks needing to be repaired prior to the pressure test.

Important Information

- Portions of this project will be constructed during the day (M-F, 7am–4pm) and at night (M-Th, 7pm–5am). Please be aware that there will be **road closures and detours** during **working hours**. Residents in the project area may experience delays due to construction but access to your property will be maintained at all times. Thank you for your understanding.
- Night work is required for the leak detection activities as road closures that minimize traffic noise are necessary to assist with the listening technology being used to detect the leaks. The contractor will attempt to perform any excavating work early in the evening (prior to 10 pm) to minimize noise while residents are sleeping. **Please note that noise on Tuesday, February 14th may extend past 10 pm on the upper and lower parts of Sacramento Street.**

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



