## **Downtown Parking Changes**

On February 28, 2017, the City Council approved changes to the City's Downtown parking program. Previous to that, the Council also approved the purchase of new parking pay stations. The new program went into effect on March 31, 2017. However, implementation has been delayed pending installation of the new parking pay stations. The new pay stations will be installed beginning on Monday, May 1, 2017. Full installation will be complete by Tuesday, May 2, 2017. Certain Pay stations will not be operational during installation. Parking enforcement will be adjusted accordingly during those times. Parking attendants will be on hand to notify customers whether or not payment is required. **Note:** 2 hour on-street parking will continue to be enforced throughout the installation process.

The following changes will be implemented after the installation of the new parking pay stations:

- Two hour free parking will continue in all lots and on the street.
- Parking enforcement will run from 8:00 am to 7:00 pm, seven days a week.
- The hourly rate will be \$2.00 after the first 2 hours of free parking.
- When paying for parking, you will be required to enter your license plate number.
- The monthly leased parking rate was changed to \$50 effective April 1, 2017.

There are other minor changes that will be enforced. However, these changes should not affect the general Public. With the new program the City anticipates being able to properly maintain the parking structure and other parking facilities. It is also our hope that the new machines will be easier to use and more customer friendly. We appreciate your cooperation during this transition.
