The City of Placerville is pleased to submit this letter to confirm the City's application for the 2017 Active Transportation Program (ATP) Augmentation of funds for the Upper Broadway Pedestrian Connection Project. This project will provide sidewalks and additional pedestrian improvements at strategic locations which will be constructed in conjunction with a bike lanes project. The pedestrian improvement in the project increases safety for the community and reduces greenhouse gas emissions.

The project schedule and funding plan has been adjusted to reflect the available augmentation funds as shown in the Project Programming Request Form. If awarded augmentation funds, the City will have a fully funded project in combination with the matching funds provided by the City and the El Dorado County Transit Authority (EDCTA). The City has coordinated with EDCTA to ensure matching funds can be provided with the accelerated schedule. Through the City's analysis, the proposed schedule will provide sufficient time for the project to be designed and constructed.

By converting the two-lane street into a modern, active transportation corridor, our community will have the choice to live out an active lifestyle on Broadway. The project provides active transportation improvements that will offer safe community access to services, transit and commerce. The proposed sidewalk and pedestrian improvements will help achieve active transportation goals and benefit our community.
