Subject: Adopt a resolution:

- 1. Ratifying a construction services contract with Doug Veerkamp General Engineering, Inc. in the amount of \$20,365.72 for emergency services performed near the intersection of Forni and Brew Road(CIP #41710); and
- 2. Authorizing the Director of Community Services to execute the same; and
- 3. Approving a \$21,000 budget liquidation from the Canal Street Reconstruction project (CIP #41821); and
- 4. Approving a budget appropriation from the Measure L Fund in the amount of \$21,000 for the Forni Road Emergency Repair project (CIP #41710).

Discussion:

On March 12, 2017, City Public Works Staff became aware of a 20'x 30' sink hole located in front of Thompsons Toyota on Forni Road. As a result of its high traffic at this location it was determined that the failure posed an imminent threat that if not addressed immediately, may cause damage to the environment and present a risk to public health, safety, and welfare. Doug Veerkamp General Engineering, Inc. was called in to make the emergency repair. The scope of work included the following:

- USA underground existing utilities and sewer services on Forni Road.
- Saw cut roadway.
- Make repair in accordance with Cal Trans Specifications.
- Dig, install bedding, back-fill, compact, and haul off spoils.
- Grind and pave 25' X 25' section of roadway over the two services and thermal re-stripe fog and center line per Caltrans specifications.
- Provide all necessary traffic control to Caltrans specifications.

Options:

- 1. Ratify the contract with Doug Veerkamp General Engineering, Inc. as presented.
- 2. Direct staff to negotiate other contract terms with Doug Veerkamp General Engineering, Inc.

Cost: \$20,365.72

Budget Impact: The repair cost of \$20,365.72 was not included in the adopted Fiscal Year 2016/2017 CIP Budget. At its meeting held on July 27, 2017, the Measures H/L Sales Tax



Committee recommended certain changes to the Measure L Fund CIP Budget including liquidating \$21,000 from the existing Canal Street Reconstruction project (CIP #41821) and reappropriating \$21,000 for the Forni Road Emergency Repair project (CIP #41710). Staff is asking the City Council to approve the Committee's recommendations.
