DUI Enforcement Operations Planned Throughout the Fair

Placerville, CA – The Placerville Police Department will be focused on DUI enforcement operations during the evening hours of the fair.

In a continued partnership with the California Office of Traffic Safety, and the AVOID the 6 program, Placerville Police Officers will be out in force patrolling the area around the fair looking for impaired drivers. DUI Saturation patrols will begin on Thursday, June 18, 2015 and continue through Sunday, June 21st, 2015.

In addition to the DUI saturation patrol, teams of officers and personnel from allied agencies will be working together to ensure a safe event. The Placerville Police Bike Patrol unit will also be roving inside and outside of the fair grounds to increase pedestrian safety. "We want the fair to be a safe, family environment," stated Traffic Sergeant Dan Maciel. "Always designate a sober driver. Don't let tragedy ruin your fun."
