- 7.1 [3177 Cedar Ravine Road – Site Plan Review \(SPR\) 2014-03 – Abuzaid Residence:](#)** Property owner Waleed Abuzaid requests Site Plan Review to replace three (3) existing single-hung wood window frames and sashes with single-hung windows on an existing home located within the Cedar Ravine Road Residential Historic District. Replacement windows would have vinyl frames and sashes and dual pane Lo-E glass. Two of the three affected windows are located along the home's Cedar Ravine Road elevation. A third affected window is located along the home's north elevation, and can be seen from Cedar Ravine Road.

The Committee is requested to identify the character defining features of the home, and to make recommendation to the Planning Commission regarding the SPR 2014-03 as to consistency with the *Secretary of Interior Standards for Rehabilitation & Guidelines for Rehabilitating Historic Buildings*.
