6. NEW BUSINESS

6.1 Exploring Historic Main Street Placerville – Tour Placerville’s Main Street.

Jacob Gray presented the 4-H GIS/ GPS project. The project consisted of historic Main Street buildings with historical descriptions, photos, and global positioning. He hopes to have it available on the city’s web site. José Crummett, GIS Manager, El Dorado County and Project Leader for the 4-H GIS/GPS project and Tracy Celio, El Dorado County 4-H Youth Development, UC Cooperative Extension provided additional background and information regarding 4-H and the project.

6.2 263 Main Street – Awning and Mural Concept.

David Becker, representing the LLC for 263 Main Street, presented his concept to have a 10’ by 20’ painted mural placed on the Center Street side of the building. Committee members were in support of the art; additional information necessary to review for consistency with the Secretary of Interior Standards for Rehabilitation and Guidelines for Rehabilitating Historic Buildings.
