Subject: Recommendation by the City Clerk that the Council confirm the appointments to the Measure H Sales Tax Committee and the Community Pride Committee, as Recommended by the City Council Interview Sub-Committee

Discussion:

The City Clerk began advertising for the various City committees in January of this year, and the recruitment closed on February 6, 2015. Following the filing deadline, the Measure H Committee had three incumbents apply for reappointment, and two of the three incumbents for Community Pride reapplied for appointment. We did, however, receive one additional candidate interested in the third Community Pride vacancy.

The City Council Sub-Committee Interview team of Vice-Mayor Patton and Councilmember Wilkins have determined that interviews need not be scheduled to fill these two City Committees. The Measure H Sales Tax Committee incumbents that are seeking reappointment: Tom Cumpston, Anthony Granados, and Elizabeth Zangari, have served this Committee as dedicated, productive members. The Community Pride Committee incumbents, Tim Daviess and Debra Power, have served on this Committee for several terms of office each and have been involved in many Community Pride projects. The new applicant for Community Pride, Craig Zangari, has lived in Placerville for over 45 years, has been employed at several Main Street businesses over the years, and is a graduate of Markham Middle School and El Dorado High School. His reason for applying for is to better serve his community. The revised rosters for Measure H and Community Pride are attached as Attachments A and B, respectively.
