



WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, Green Acres Program (“State”), provides loans and/or grants to municipal and county governments and grants to nonprofit organizations for assistance in the acquisition and development of lands for outdoor recreation and conservation purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Township Nutley has previously obtained a loan of **\$501,250** and a grant of **\$248,750** from the State to fund the following project:

#0716-07-040, Monsignor Owens Park Re-Development

WHEREAS, the State and the Township of Nutley intend to amend the Green Acres funding ratio for a loan of **\$416,840**; and a Grant of **\$333,160** in addition to a **\$150,000** Essex County Open Space Grant; and

WHEREAS, the applicant is willing to use the State’s funds in accordance with its rules, regulations and applicable statutes, and is willing to enter into an Amendment of the Agreement with the State for the above-named project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Nutley, County of Essex, New Jersey, that:

1. The **Mayor** of the above named body or board is hereby authorized to execute an agreement and any amendment thereto with the State known as **Monsignor Owens Park Development (#0716-07-040)**.
