2 MAYOR PETRACCO: -- I'd like to welcome everyone to
3 commission chambers for our celebration this afternoon. I
4 think first, we should all stand and do the flag salute. And
5 then we'll follow it by the Star Spangled Banner.

6 (Pledge of Allegiance)

7 MAYOR PETRACCO: Please remain standing.

8 Tina Johnson will now do the Star Spangled Banner.

9 (Star Spangled Banner)

10 (Applause)

11 MAYOR PETRACCO: Let's hear it for Tina one more
12 time.

13 Great job.

14 (Applause)

15 MAYOR PETRACCO: Okay, Madam Clerk, please read
16 the Sunshine Act.

17 MADAM CLERK: Yes, Mayor. The time is now 12:05.

18 Pursuant to the requirements of the Open Public
19 Meeting Law, Chapter 231, notice of this meeting was
20 published in the December 24, 2015 issues of the Nutley Sun,
21 the Star Ledger, and the Herald News. A copy of this notice

1 MADAM CLERK: Commissioner Tucci?

2 COMMISSIONER TUCCI: Here.

15 JUDGE COCCHIOLA: Here.

16 MAYOR PETRACCO: Thank you.

17 At this time, we'd like to bring Father Tom
18 Nicastro and all the reverends up for the invocation,
19 please.

20 (Pause)

21 FATHER NICASTRO: In the name of the Father and of
22 the Son, of the Holy Spirit, amen. Let us pray.

23 Almighty and eternal God, you have revealed your
24 glory to all nations. God of power and might, wisdom and
25 justice, through you authority, is rightly administered and

1 laws are enacted. And judgment is decreed. Assist with
2 your spirit of counsel and fortitude these men who today
3 take the oath of office as commissioners here in the town of
4 Nutley and one who will govern as mayor of this township.
5 Watch over them and their families. Protect and bless each
6 of them with wisdom, honesty, integrity, right judgment,
7 good health, and fairness to all.

8 May they always execute laws with justice and
9 mercy and seek to restrain crime, vice, and immorality. As
10 elected officials, may they guard our political welfare.
11 May they be enabled by your guidance and powerful protection
12 to discharge their duties with honesty and ability. We pray
13 for our township after this period of campaigning with the
14 hope that all those elected will lead at every level and
15 work for the common good of all people who dwell here.

16 Heavenly Father, God of all wisdom, as we gather
17 on this day of inauguration and new beginnings, imbue these
18 elected officials with an abundance of wisdom, patience,
19 right judgment, and the necessary strength of character to
20 do the right thing and always make wise, unselfish, and
21 sound choices. May they avoid making erroneous decisions
22 that will adversely affect the welfare of all. As they
23 begin to meet and organize and plan for the years ahead,
24 which will be filled with many projects that can bring
25 prosperity and financial security to this township, aid them

1 to be patient with one another and refrain from discord and
2 malice, always seeking harmony and effective compromise.

3 This afternoon, we pray for wisdom, not rhetoric,
4 generosity, not indifference, and justice, not patronage.
5 May they not erect barriers by harsh words, but build
6 bridges that bring many together through kindness and
7 charity. And we pray for leaders gifted in diplomacy,
8 blessed with character and integrity, and leaders who know
9 that our security comes from relationships of trust and
10 communication, not divisiveness.

11 Father, as we prayerfully reflect, may we recall
12 the words of I Timothy in the Holy Book, which speaks about
13 praying for those in authority. "First of all, then I ask
14 that supplications, prayers, petitions, and thanksgiving be
15 offered for everyone, for kings and for all in authority
16 that we may lead a quiet and tranquil life in all devotion
17 and dignity." And for our part, give each of us patience so
18 that we may in turn give to our officials a chance to govern
19 with grace and compassion, justice, love, and support, and
20 sincere effort to celebrate sage decision making.

21 Likewise, Father, we commend to your unbounded
22 mercy all the constituents of the township of Nutley. May
23 we preserve in union that peace which the world cannot give
24 and after enjoying the blessings of this life, be admitted
25 to those which are eternal. We make this prayer through

1 Christ, our Lord. Amen. In the name of the Father, and of
2 the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

23 board member in Nutley, we have the famous Tony Iannarone
24 (ph). Also from the planning board, attorney Barry Kozyra
25 (ph); from the zoning board, Diane McGovern.

20 their time and efforts.

22 MAYOR SCARPELLI: And congratulations to Alan Genitempo
23 and Angelo Servidio on their reappointments.

24 (Applause)

25 MAYOR SCARPELLI: A special thanks to my guardian

1 angels, who have guided me throughout this last year, my
2 grandmother and grandfather; my brother, Mike; my nephew,
3 Michael; my Uncle Ralph; and, of course, Kevin, whose sage
4 advice came in a different form this election. I miss you
5 all, but I know you're all here today.

6 (Applause)

7 MAYOR SCARPELLI: Could Antonio Pignatero (ph),
8 who came to America and bought a piece of land on Milton
9 Avenue in the 1890s ever imagine that, not only would his
10 great-grandson become mayor of Nutley, but also his great,
11 great-grandson? Only in America. The first time in our
12 history a father and son served as mayor.

13 (Applause)

14 MAYOR SCARPELLI: Not bad for a family from Nanny
15 Goat Hill. It is obvious from the election results that the
16 people like the direction the town is going with all five
17 commissioners being reelected. It will be my honor to lead
18 this Board of Commissioners and this town over the next four
19 years.

20 We have a unique town with many traditions that
21 need to be preserved. And I pledge to keep this town, as
22 much as I can, like the town we grew up in. But there are

11 existing buildings, smart redevelopment that replaced our
12 lost rateables and take into consideration the inability of
13 our schools to accommodate additional children, smart
14 redevelopment that complements rather than competes with our
15 downtown, and smart redevelopment that provides a big boost
16 to our local economy.

17 I would like to thank Darian Wilson (ph) from
18 Roche, Kevin DiSimone (ph) from Hackensack Medical Center,
19 and Matt Meroic (ph) from Seton Hall University for joining
20 with us today and look forward to our partnering with them
21 as we move forward. Would you please stand?

22 (Applause)

23 MAYOR SCARPELLI: Other challenges we will face
24 over the next four years -- improving our schools and
25 finding viable long-term solutions to the overcrowding

1 issue; revitalizing our downtown, and the successful
2 transformation of the East Centre Street Corridor to a
3 neighborhood that is cohesive and connected to our parks.
4 These are big issues that need big ideas. I believe that
5 this Board of Commissioners, with their knowledge and
6 experience, is prepared to meet those challenges. Thank you
7 for the privilege of serving the people of Nutley as your
8 eighteenth mayor.

9 I pledge to my fellow commissioners open
10 communication and respect of our form of government and will
11 do my utmost to uphold the confidence of the voters and this
12 board to lead us into the next phase of our history. God
13 bless this town, and God bless this Board of Commissioners.
14 Thank you.

16 MAYOR SCARPELLI: Commissioner Petracco?

17 COMMISSIONER PETRACCO: Mayor, unfortunately, my
18 son, Salvatore, had a bathroom emergency.

19 MAYOR SCARPELLI: Would you like to wait?

20 COMMISSIONER PETRACCO: So if I could wait, that
21 would be appreciated.

22 MAYOR SCARPELLI: Great.

23 Commissioner Evans?

24 COMMISSIONER EVANS: Thank you, Mayor. You know,
25 as I reflected on the election and the prior 13 years of

1 service to the community as a sitting commissioner,
2 especially sitting in the seat for 13 years, which as your

21 to serve every resident in town equally to provide them the
22 best service that they can. And I'm very proud of them.

23 Both my mom and dad have passed. As a child, they
24 instilled in all of us the importance of service to others.
25 I suspect that's why I became a CPA and ultimately spent my

1 adult career in a partnership environment where ethos,
2 values, and service were the guiding principles of my every-
3 day actions.

4 To all those Nutley voters who came out to vote, I
5 thank you. To all the Nutley voters who actually cast a
6 vote for me, I want to thank you for placing your trust in
7 me once again. I will work very hard to earn your trust
8 every day.

9 We have much to do. As the mayor just
10 articulated, the town is at a crossroads. We must be able
11 to think as a board to come up with the solutions that make
12 sense for all of us. I pray for God's blessings to shine
13 upon me, to fortify me with the firmness of virtue, with the
14 humble strength of character so that I may lead in the best
15 interests of all Nutley residents and for our future
16 beneficiaries and to do that without personal interest.

17 I have led my professional career and partnership
18 this way. I have instilled this in my children and now my
19 grandson.

20 I want to congratulate my fellow commissioners. I
21 wish them these same blessings. And to my fellow
22 commissioners and to my mayor, let's get back to work.

2 reverend clergy, honored guests, first I'd like to
3 congratulate all of my colleagues on their success at the
4 polls last week.

5 I'd like to wish Mayor Scarpelli well as he begins
6 his tenure. I know he's going to do an excellent job for
7 us, and I support him completely.

8 I'd also like to thank our former mayor, Alphonse
9 Petracco, for his four years of service during really tough
10 times. Al took over as mayor, and we got a letter from
11 Roche saying, "We're leaving." Needless to say, a lot of
12 time, a lot of hard work went into bringing us to where we
13 are today, citing that medical school, developing that
14 property.

15 And, Al, I thank you for your service in that
16 regard.

12 here today, Ralph's assemblymate, my sister-in-law, Liz
13 Muoio (ph).

18 enough for all the fine work that you do, all the support

21 office, many monumental decisions are going to need to be

1 you down.

7 something different here. And I believe that what is
8 different is the hand of Almighty God.

9 We all have a calling, every single person in this
10 room. Some callings are very, very difficult, and others
11 are not. But we're all called by God to do good.

12 So a few things we're going to do in the Public
13 Affairs Department -- we're going to be working on programs
14 that will help those children, families, and mothers who
15 suffer drug addiction. I weep because a few weeks ago, four
16 mothers walked into my office on a Saturday morning whose
17 children died at a young age as a result of drug abuse. But
18 we're going to work hard to combat that.

19 Assemblymen, we're going to be looking for your
20 help to help change some laws in the legislature. But we're
21 going to treat some of this -- you know, I promised I
22 wouldn't cry today. I said to myself I wouldn't, but you
23 can't when it hits your heart, folks.

24 I looked at these mothers, and they pleaded for
25 help. They've gotten a lot of help from our town, the Hope

1 Committee with the mayor.

2 The judge -- you've been a wonderful judge, a
3 wonderful judge. You've done so much good for people and
4 every commissioner here. But we've got to treat some of
5 that as a mental health problem and not a criminal problem.

6 Young children addicted to drugs and even parents
7 and adults -- they need some help. They'll get help from
8 the government, but they're going to get help from someone
9 else, from another group. And this is where a program we
10 have been putting together is going to be given birth in the
11 next four years. You all know what we've done with the
12 veterans in town, and that's rock solid. And that
13 initiative in this town will be here forever.

14 But we -- not I, we endeavor to launch one of the
15 most progressive interfaith initiatives in the state of New
16 Jersey to include you gentlemen, you priests, you ministers.
17 Because I found something out very early in speaking to
18 these individuals. As the government, we can do a lot. But
19 boy, we can't get into the heart, soul, and spirit of these
20 people who are hurting. You can. You're going to be
21 involved.

22 And I thank you for the service that you've given
23 this town. We haven't thanked you enough. Thank you very
24 much.

25 (Applause)

1 COMMISSIONER ROGERS: As we move forward, I know
2 that I've got a great staff at public affairs. And I'm going
3 to sound like a broken record. But every single man up here
4 and woman -- when this town was in need, when one individual
5 is in need, they all stepped up, every single one of them.

6 I look forward, Mayor, to working with you and all
7 of you for the next four years. Sorry for the tears. But,
8 you know, I'm kind of a softy inside sometimes. But like I
9 said, these things hit your heart. And I thank God that I'm
10 here to help out. Thank you, and God bless you all.

11

12 (Applause)

13 MAYOR SCARPELLI: Commissioner Petracco?

14 COMMISSIONER PETRACCO: You know, next time,
15 Mayor, I think I have to go before Steve. He's a hard act
16 to follow.

17 First, I just want to recognize everyone that came
18 out today, all the people that keep us safe in Nutley day,
19 night, holidays, rain, snow. And that's our Public Safety
20 Department. I see all the cops and firemen here.

21 (Applause)

22 COMMISSIONER PETRACCO: I see Michael Rossi (ph),
23 from the ambulance squad. The finest in the country.

24 Thank you, Michael, for coming.

25 Let's give the ambulance squad a round of

1 applause.

2 (Applause)

3 COMMISSIONER PETRACCO: As you all know, I don't
4 usually read my speeches. But I've left so many people out
5 through the years. So please, just bear with me.

6 First of all, I would like to thank and -- I would
7 like to congratulate all my colleagues on the board for
8 their reelection. I would also like to thank my family,
9 starting with the two most honorable people I know, my
10 mother and father.

11 Thank you for always being there for me and my
12 family. Thank you for all the family values that you have
13 taught me, especially the number one rule, family always
14 comes first.

15 I would like to thank my beautiful wife for all
16 her patience, understanding, and finding in her heart to
17 give me the opportunity to follow my dreams and hold down
18 the fort while I am away from home. You are truly my soul
19 mate, and I would only want you in my life.

20 I would like to thank my two brothers for always
21 going to bat for me, even if I wasn't always 100 percent
22 right. You have both shown me unconditional love since we
23 were kids growing up on Park Avenue. You both know where I
24 stand with you, always by each other's sides, no matter
25 what.

1 My children, Sonny, Vincent, and Salvatore, Daddy
2 couldn't be more proud of you. Fine young men that you have
3 turned out to be.

4 My son, Vincent, couldn't be here -- could not be
5 here today. He is at Seton University today in class
6 studying to become a doctor, where he has been on the dean's
7 list since he started.

8 My son, Sonny -- there could never be a kid that
9 has so many of their father's characteristics as my son,
10 Sonny. Last 20 years, everyone has told me he's just like
11 you.

12 (Pause)

13 COMMISSIONER PETRACCO: Somebody could make some
14 noise in here, right? My God.

15 I am so proud of you, Sonny.

16 He is entering his last year in Montclair
17 University. And then he will continue his education in law
18 at Seton Hall University. He is the only one of my kids
19 that wants to ever enter in politics in Nutley. I keep
20 telling him the only chair you should aspire to be here is
21 the town attorney chair over there.

22 Moving along to my son, Salvatore, who is -- yes,
23 there is a big spread in years in my children. Sometimes
24 people think I am his grandfather. I am his father.

25 I would like to tell you a little story Sal and I

1 had the past Friday night. That story was when I came home
2 Friday night -- which as all the commissioners know. The
3 thing that suffers the most is your family.

4 And I said to my son, Salvatore -- I said, "Hey,
5 Sal, you know, are you a little disappointed that daddy
6 didn't become the mayor again?" He goes, "Well, Dad --" and
7 mind you, he's eight. He says, "You know, Dad, I was born
8 into this stuff. I didn't have a choice."

9 He says, "When I was born, you were the
10 commissioner." He goes, "And I hardly ever saw you. Then
11 when I think it couldn't get any worse," he goes, "you
12 became the mayor, and I really didn't see you." He goes, "I
13 have to tell you the truth. I was hoping you were going to
14 lose the whole thing."

15 (Laughter)

16 (Applause)

17 COMMISSIONER PETRACCO: I would also like to thank
18 -- start over. I would also like to thank all that were on
19 the campaign trail. There is too many to thank by name, but
20 I would like to thank -- I would like to thank all of them.
21 I would be remiss not to give a special thank you to Linda
22 Diacheysn (ph) and Sam Carella (ph), Lisa Hollard (ph), Dana
23 Melillo (ph), and Cathy Kelly (ph).

24 Thank you to all for being there for me, not only
25 for -- and not only for the campaign, but always in my life.

1 Thank you.

2 I would also like to thank Chief Paul Cafone and
3 Chief Tom Strumolo for running two great agencies and also
4 for rallying the troops for me. You are two good friends.

5 I'm almost done. I would also like to thank all
6 of our friends up the street at the ambulance squad.
7 Speaking of friends, God blessed me with so many good
8 friends. And I would like to acknowledge a few of them
9 today. Louie Fusaro (ph), Bill Algieri (ph), Joe Valano
10 (ph), and Gerry Greene (ph) and also Tommy Melillo.

11 Let's give them a round of applause.

12 (Applause)

13 COMMISSIONER PETRACCO: I would also like to give
14 a shout out to my best friends, besides, of course,
15 Salvatore. But I'd like to give a shout out to SYA and Annie
16 Rotundo (ph).

17 You truly are doing God's work.

18 I'd also like to thank everyone from the deli.
19 Lord knows I've been absentee there for eight years.

20 And Johnny, my nephew; Anthony; Austin Silverstein
21 (ph), I couldn't do it without you.

22 I would also like to thank Father Tom and his
23 brother, Dominic (ph), for being there for me.

24 In closing, once again, I would like to thank all
25 of the -- all of the commissioners for voting for me to be

1 the mayor for the last four years. It has truly been a
2 wonderful journey.

3 Mauro, I would like to thank you for always being
4 by my side through the Roche committee. You're a true
5 professional, and I am proud to call you my friend.

6 (Applause)

7 COMMISSIONER PETRACCO: To our newly-elected
8 Mayor, Joe, I blame you for getting me into this game of
9 politics. Way back when when you were the county
10 freeholder, I came to one of your functions. And I said,
11 "Wow, this is pretty cool." If I only knew. Anyway, Joe,
12 there is -- anyway, Joe, there is no better honor than being
13 the Nutley mayor.

14 (Pause)

15 COMMISSIONER PETRACCO: I'm still tough, guys.
16 I'm still tough, right? But there -- but to be the Nutley
17 -- but to be the mayor of Nutley -- Nutley is a very special
18 place and a place we all love. And Nutley is lucky to have
19 my good friend, Joe Scarpelli.

20 (Applause)

21 MAYOR SCARPELLI: Thank you, Al. And I'm sure
22 Puffy's looking down on us today.

23 Madam Clerk, any presentations?

24 MADAM CLERK: No, Mayor, we have no presentations.

25 MAYOR SCARPELLI: I'm going to have Tina come up

1 and lead us in song before we adjourn.

2 (Song)

3 (Applause)

4 MAYOR SCARPELLI: Thank you, Tina. That was
5 beautiful.

6 You're all invited in the back for coffee and
7 cake. I guess I'm going to look to Commissioner Rogers.

8 Do we have a motion?

9 COMMISSIONER ROGERS: A lot of emotion, but good
10 emotion.

11 I move that we close this session.

12 COMMISSIONER PETRACCO: Second.

13 MADAM CLERK: Commissioner Rogers?

14 COMMISSIONER ROGERS: Aye.

15 MADAM CLERK: Commissioner Tucci?

16 COMMISSIONER TUCCI: Aye.

17 MADAM CLERK: Commissioner Evans?

18 COMMISSIONER EVANS: Aye.

19 MADAM CLERK: Commissioner Petracco?

20 COMMISSIONER PETRACCO: Aye.

21 MADAM CLERK: Mayor Scarpelli?

22 MAYOR SCARPELLI: Aye.

23 MADAM CLERK: And the time is now 1:26.

24 MAYOR SCARPELLI: We hope to see you all tonight
25 at our meeting. Thank you all for coming. We really

1 appreciate the support.

2 COMMISSIONER ROGERS: Yeah, thank you.

3 (Applause)
