Help us welcome him back to the Kingsland Manor.



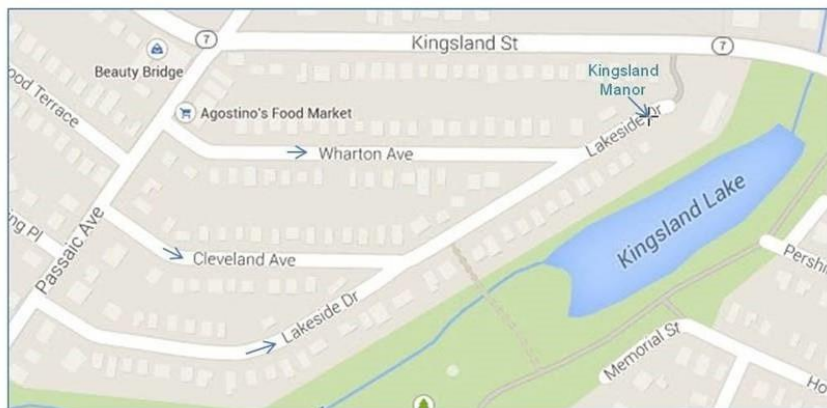
