2 2012 Pursuant to the requirements of the
3 Open Public Meeting Law, Chapter 231, Public
4 Laws 1975, notice of this meeting was
5 published in the December 22nd, 2011 issues of
6 the Nutley Sun, the Star Ledger and the Herald
7 News. A copy of this notice has been posted
8 on the Nutley Town Hall bulletin board, and a
9 copy is on file in the municipal clerk's
10 office. Commissioner Scarpelli?

11 COMMISSIONER SCARPELLI: Here.

12 MADAM CLERK: Commissioner Petracco?

13 COMMISSIONER PETRACCO: Here.

14 MADAM CLERK: Commissioner Evans is
15 absent/excused this evening. Mayor Tucci?

16 MAYOR TUCCI: Here.

17 MADAM CLERK: All present, Mayor,
18 with the exception of Commissioner Evans who
19 is absent/excused this evening.

20 MAYOR TUCCI: Thank you. I see we
21 have no minutes this evening, Madam Clerk?

22 MADAM CLERK: That's correct, Mayor.

23 MAYOR TUCCI: And we have no
24 correspondence this evening or communications?

25 MADAM CLERK: That's correct, Mayor.

1 MAYOR TUCCI: We have no reports.
2 We have no ordinance introductions, no public
3 hearings, so we'll move right into
4 resolutions.

5 MADAM CLERK: Bills.

6 MAYOR TUCCI: Commission -- bills?
7 Oh, I'm sorry. I keep wanting to go by the
8 bills.

9 MADAM CLERK: Okay.

10 MAYOR TUCCI: Okay, bills please?

11 MADAM CLERK: Yes, Mayor. Tuesday

9 Commissioner Scarpelli, will you please read
10 the Commissioner Evans' resolutions?

11 COMMISSIONER SCARPELLI: Sure,
12 Mayor. "Be it resolved by the Board of
13 Commissioners of Township of Nutley, County of
14 Essex, New Jersey, the Township enter into an
15 agreement with the New Jersey Association for
16 Retarded Citizens, Essex County Unit, a New
17 Jersey Corporation, with offices at Naylor
18 Avenue in the Township of Livingston in Essex
19 County, New Jersey, wherein the "Unit" agrees
20 to provide services to mentally retarded
21 individuals and their families in the Township
22 of Nutley, effective January 1, 2012 through
23 December 31, 2012, in consideration of payment
24 by the Township of Nutley to the "Unit" of
25 \$1,000.00, payable in one sum, as a partial

1 reimbursement of costs and services"e

2 "Be it further resolved that the
3 Mayor and the Township Clerk are hereby
4 authorized and directed to execute said
5 agreement on behalf of the Township of Nutley"
6 and move the resolutione

7 COMMISSIONER PETRACCO: Seconde

8 MADAM CLERK: Commissioner
9 Scarpelli?

10 COMMISSIONER SCARPELLI: Aye

11 MADAM CLERK: Commissioner Petracco?

14 MAYOR TUCCI: Aye

15 COMMISSIONER SCARPELLI: "Whereas,
16 the Township of Nutley and Northwest Essex
17 Community Healthcare Network..., 570
18 Belleville Avenue, Belleville ..., desire to
19 enter into a contract wherein the Community
20 Mental Health Services will provide mental
21 health services to Nutley residents"e

22 "Whereas, it is in the best interest
23 in the Township of Nutley to enter into this
24 agreement for a fee of \$10,000 for 2012".

25 "[T]herefore, be it resolved by the

1 Board of Commissioners of the Township of
2 Nutley, County of Essex, New Jersey that the
3 Director of Public Affairs and the Township
4 Clerk are hereby authorized to execute an
5 agreement with Northwest Essex Community
6 Healthcare Network. Move the resolution.

7 COMMISSIONER PETRACCO: Second.

8 MADAM CLERK: Commissioner

10 COMMISSIONER SCARPELLI: Aye.

11 MADAM CLERK: Commissioner Petracco?

14 MAYOR TUCCI: I abstain.

15 COMMISSIONER SCARPELLI: "Whereas,
16 there exists a need for a 2012 Election Ballot
17 Design and Printing Services for the Township
18 of Nutley Municipal Election."

19 "Whereas, the Local Public Contract
20 Law NJSA 40A:11-5(1)... permits the award of
21 contracts for certain professional services
22 without competitive bidding 'Goods and
23 Services Necessary or Required to Prepare and
24 Conduct an Election'.

25 "Whereas, Reliance Graphics ..., 80

1 Pompton Avenue, Verona, New Jersey 07044 has
2 submitted a proposal; and

3 "Whereas, the contract is in the
4 amount not to exceed \$13,350.00 and funds are
5 available in account number 2-01-210-232 as
6 evidence by the Chief Financial Officer's
7 certification attached hereto; and

8 "Now, therefore, be it resolved by
9 the Board of Commissioners of the Township of
10 Nutley, as follows, that Reliance Graphics ...
11 be retained to design the 2012 Municipal
12 Election Ballot and provide the election
13 printing services as required; and

14 "Be it further resolved, that the
15 contract is awarded without competitive
16 bidding in accordance with NJSA 40A:41-
17 5(1)..., an exception under the law because
18 the contract is for 'Goods and Services
19 Necessary or Required to Prepare and Conduct
20 an Election.'

21 "Be it further resolved, that a
22 notice of this action shall be published in
23 accordance with the law."

20 MADAM CLERK: Mayor Tucci?

21 COMMISSIONER SCARPELLI: That's all
22 I have, Mayor.

23 MAYOR TUCCI: Thank you.

24 Commissioner Petracco, do you have anything
25 this evening?

1 COMMISSIONER PETRACCO: I have
2 nothing, Mayor.

3 MAYOR TUCCI: Okay. "Whereas, on
4 June 27th, Mr. Joseph Cerreto of the Game
5 Sports Bar & Grill submitted a video license
6 application and a fee of \$600.00 for the
7 licensing of two (2) video machines at the
8 location of 35@ Passaic Avenue; and

9 "Whereas the video licenses were
10 never issued; and

11 "Whereas, Chapter 309, Section 10,
12 Article II of the Nutley Code permits for the
13 refund of the application fee if the video
14 license(s) is not issued.

15 "Now, therefore, be it resolved, by
16 the Board of Commissioners of the Township of
17 Nutley, County of Essex, in the State of New
18 Jersey that the Treasurer be and she is hereby
19 authorized to refund the licensing fee of
20 \$525e00 (... nonrefundable fee for
21 investigation and processing...) to Mr. Joseph
22 Cerreto, owner of the Game Sports Bar &
23 Grill."

9 Lightpath, 200 Jericho Quadrangle, Jericho,
10 New York...; and

11 "Whereas, the Superintendent of the
12 Parks and Public Property has recommended the
13 following change order from said Contract as
14 necessary:

16 for informational services and communications
17 services" in the amount of 6,600 dollars.

18 "Whereas, funds are available from
19 account 510-237 and have been certified by the
20 Chief Financial Officer and said

20 59, the following transfer of 2011
21 Appropriation Reserves be and the same are
22 hereby authorized and approved:"

23 In the Department of Parks and
24 Public Property, from Group Insurance, 11,000
25 dollars to Shade Tree other expenses in the

1 same amount of 11,000 dollars.

2 I move the resolution.

3 COMMISSIONER PETRACCO: Second.

4 MADAM CLERK: Commissioner

5 Scarpelli? Commissioner Petracco, Mayor

6 Tucci?

7 MAYOR TUCCI: Aye.

8 What I'd like to do now, is I'd like
9 to just have a moment of silence for volunteer
10 firefighter, Scott Bellucci, who passed away a
11 few days ago.

12 (Pause)

13 MAYOR TUCCI: Okay, now I'd like to
14 open the meeting to the public. All persons
15 addressing the Board of Commissioners
16 regarding community concerns should approach
17 the microphone and provide their name and
18 address for the record. Unless further time
19 is granted by the board, each person shall
20 limit their address to five minutes. All
21 remarks to the board and its individual
22 members must be addressed to the Mayor.

23 The Mayor may defer citizen comments
24 to the appropriate member of the board.
25 Dialogue between citizens and others

1 addressing the board shall be allowed unless
2 the Mayor or presiding officer or the majority
3 of the membership of the board shall determine
4 that the interests of decorum and/or the
5 expeditious conduct of municipal business are
6 being adversely affected by such dialogue.

7 Anyone who would like to --

8 MS. QUIRK: Teri Quirk, 45 Hampton
9 Place, spokesperson for the Nutley Parent
10 Advocacy Network. I promise, Commissioner
11 Scarpelli, that I'm going to be very briefe I
12 promise.

13 Tonight, I'm coming to you with a
14 problem, a concern, and I just wanted to share
15 it with you because it's a very sensitive
16 topic. And it's something that came to me in
17 confidence. And it's just something that's so
18 prevalent in society todaye

19 We had a mother come to us in
20 regards to a bullying situation in one of the
21 elementary schoolse And we handled it as we
22 should. And we start to learn about this
23 mother and this particular childe And we
24 learned that this child had been recently
25 sexually abused by a family friend who is now

1 incarcerated.

2 The impact on this situation with
3 this family has been so difficult for them to
4 try to navigate through because there's such
5 shame and guilt in this entire situation.
6 Instead of the person who actually is the
7 perpetrator doing the crime, it's really the
8 people who are victimized by this.

9 So we wanted to really help this
10 mother, and we really didn't know how to. So
11 we've come up with an idea because she really
12 wanted to have a support group with other
13 parents. And it's really hard to sort of
14 out --- you know, go out there and try to find
15 other parents in the same predicament.

16 However, there are other parents in
17 the same predicament, and there are other
18 children in the same predicament. We don't
19 like to talk about this in Nutley. And we
20 don't like to talk about this anywhere. And
21 nobody liked to talk about it in Penn State,
22 and we can see what happened there.

23 But the issue here is that, you
24 know, what can we do for these parents. And
25 we were lucky enough to go through our

1 network, and we found a speaker that is
2 willing to come and speak. She's a clinical
3 psychologist from Montclair State University,
4 and she's willing to help us.

5 Now, the reason why I'm coming to
6 you is that I know you know many more people
7 than I do. And I just want you to help us get
8 the word out when the time comes that we will
9 have this workshop, and we do want parents to
10 feel comfortable. We want members of the
11 community to feel comfortable to come forward.

12 I have to tell you, I have two
13 friends who came to me and told me that they
14 were sexually abused as young children -- as
15 three or four or five years old, and they have
16 lived with this their entire life. So we
17 shouldn't be shamed. We shouldn't be
18 victimized by this. We should be able to
19 understand this problem and really support the
20 people that need this.

21 So when the time comes, I will
22 certainly share that with you and the public.
23 But if you know of anyone, please let them
24 know that this is coming, okay?

25 MAYOR TUCCI: Teri, can I ask a

1 couple questions?

2 MSe QUIRK: Sure.

3 MAYOR TUCCI: Is the NPAN doing
4 this?

5 MSe QUIRK: Yes Yes

6 MAYOR TUCCI: You're the sponsoring
7 organization?

8 MSe QUIRK: Yes Thank youe

9 COMMISSIONER PETRACCO: What kind of
10 help are you looking for?

11 MSe QUIRK: Well, just you might
12 have people that might come to you in
13 confidence, just like they have to us. And
14 just say, you know what, NPAN is putting
15 together this workshope We would really like
16 to have a support group come from thise

17 But first we'd like to actually have
18 the workshop to see how many people will kind
19 of come out and -- and it doesn't even have to
20 be a parent or a childe It could be -- it
21 could be a member from the community who's
22 gone through something similar to this. I
23 mean, you know, a lot of these issues that
24 happen to these people are never really
25 addressede They never reallye you know, get a

1 chance to really resolve it.

2 So sometimes having a person, such
3 as this particular speaker, who is -- like I
4 said, she's a professor up at Montclair State
5 College. She's a clinical psychologist.
6 She's somebody who's an expert in this field.
7 So I just think it's really important for, you
8 know, someone of that stature to come in.

9 MAYOR TUCCI: I'm going to make a
10 suggestion, is that -- you know, we have -- we
11 just introduced the Northwest Essex today
12 about -- through Public Affairs.

13 MS. QUIRK: Mm-hmm.

14 MAYOR TUCCI: And we have Family
15 Service Bureau, and I think to work with those
16 two organizations --

17 MS. QUIRK: Sure.

18 MAYOR TUCCI: -- with this because
19 this is a sensitive topic. And you're going
20 to have this in a public setting. You may
21 need people who will need some support along
22 with that.

23 MS. QUIRK: Right.

24 MAYOR TUCCI: So I think it's in the
25 best interest to involve --

1 MS. QUIRK: Absolutely.

2 MAYOR TUCCI: -- some of the
3 resources at our disposal.

4 MSe QUIRK: Okay, I will reach out
5 to them.

6 COMMISSIONER PETRACCO: What is the
7 date?

8 MS. QUIRK: I don't know at this
9 pointe But that's real tentative. But once I
10 find out I will let you know. Okay? All
11 right.

12 COMMISSIONER SCARPELLI: Teri, I
13 think this is a wonderful idea. I think it's
14 something that --

15 MSe QUIRK: Oh, thank you.

16 COMMISSIONER SCARPELLI: -- that
17 should be spoken to. I think people should
18 have an avenue where they can come out and
19 speak with other folks and share their
20 feelings and get some suggestions as to how
21 they move beyond this and how they continue in
22 their lives. So whatever we can do as a --

23 MS. QUIRK: Righte

24 MAYOR TUCCI: -- body, I'm sure
25 we'll stand --

1 MALE SPEAKER: Cathy (ph.) wanted to

2 --

3 MAYOR TUCCI: Yes, Cathye

4 (Break in audio)

5 CATHY: -- covered at the same --

6 (break in audio) -- I would encourage people

7 (break in audio) -- go to Northwest -- (break

8 in audio).

9 MAYOR TUCCI: And if you need that
10 contact information --

11 MS. QUIRK: Yes, I --

12 MAYOR TUCCI: -- I'm sure Cathy has
13 it. We all have it, yeaye

14 MSe QUIRK: Thank you very muche

15 MAYOR TUCCI: Thank you. Anyone
16 else?

17 COMMISSIONER SCARPELLI: Motion to
18 adjourn.
