17 facsimile signatures. Now, therefore, be it resolved by the
18 Board of Commissioners of the township of Nutley, county of

20 hereby authorized to honor for the account of and to the
21 debit of the township of Nutley each check or draft for the
22 payment of money bearing a facsimile signature of the
23 following. Mayor, director of revenue and finance, township
24 clerk, chief financial officer, so long as said checks
25 contain one manual authorized signature.

1 Be it further resolved that the bank may rely on
2 this resolution until receipt of the bank of a certified
3 copy of a resolution of the Board of Commissioners revoking
4 the same, the township expressly assuming all risks involved
5 in any unauthorized use of said facsimile signatures. Be it
6 further resolved that the township clerk be and she is
7 hereby directed to furnish TD Bank and Capitol One Bank with
8 a certified copy of this resolution. So move.

9 MR. TUCCIe Second.

24 meeting current township expenses or for the purpose of
25 affecting investments.

1 Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Board of
2 Commissioners of the township of Nutley, county of Essex
3 that it does hereby authorize the chief financial officer to
4 request bids and to place orders for the investment of idle
5 funds solely in legal, authorized investment vehicles, such
6 investments for the investing into -- to the investing
7 institution, and be it further resolved the above named
8 chief financial officer is hereby authorized to transfer
9 funds by wire solely for -- for the following purposes and
10 subject to pertinent regulations.

11 To and from township checking account to other
12 township accounts, to and from township checking or savings
13 accounts, to and from accounts specified by banks or the
14 state of New Jersey Cash Management Fund solely for the
15 purpose of investing for the account of the township of
16 Nutley, from township checking accounts solely for the
17 purpose of making investments of current township expenses
18 which have been approved.

19 Just to be clear, this investing is not in mutual
20 funds or stocks or anything. It's simply savings accounts
21 and money management accounts that are secured by the --
22 actually, the -- the U.S. Treasury. So they're very secure
23 funds. So we're not investing in anything that has a risk
24 base.

25 So move.

1 MR. TUCCI: Second.

2 UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: Commissioner Rogers?

3 MR. ROGERS: Aye.

4 UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: Commissioner Tucci?

5 MR. TUCCI: Aye.

6 UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: Commissioner Evans?

7 MR. EVANS: Aye.

8 UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: Commissioner Scarpelli?

9 MR. SCARPELLI: Aye.

10 UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: Mayor Petracco?

11 MR. PETRACCO: Aye.

12 If it's okay with everyone, I'm going to -- we're
13 going to save the statements for last, and we're going to
14 move on to presentations.

15 Ann Mega is here from the office of
16 Congressman Bill Pascrell for a presentation.

17 Ann?

18 (Applause.)

19 MS. MEGA: On behalf of Congressman Bill Pascrell,
20 who is in Washington and extends his congratulations to each
21 and every one of you, I have a letter signed by the
22 congressman for each one of you extending his
23 congratulations to each of you. It's a pleasure for me
24 personally to be here. Four of you I know quite well. One
25 of you I've known since he was a teenager.

1 And Mr. Rogers it's a pleasure to meet you.

2 Again, congratulations to all of you, and I wish
3 you four years of success. Thanks for having me.

4 (Applause.)

5 MR. PETRACCO: Thank you so much, Ann.

6 Now, we'd like to call up Brenda Sherman from the
7 office of Congressman Rodney Frelinghuysen.

8 (Applause.)

9 MS. SHERMAN: Thank you very much. On behalf of
10 Congressman Rodney Frelinghuysen, who represents the 11th
11 District and is also in Washington today, he wanted to
12 extend his congratulations to each one of you. I do have a
13 letter. It is not signed yet, because it was a last-minute
14 iPad delivery, but he did want me to extend his
15 congratulations and briefly read that he, "would like to
16 congratulate each one of you on your election this past
17 week. I look forward to working with each of you to assure
18 effective representation for Nutley."

19 And I would like to say on a personal note, since
20 I know each one of you, I'd like to congratulate you on your
21 reelections and your election, and I look forward to working
22 with each one of you, and I know in my heart you will
23 continue to work just as hard as you have in the past into
24 the future. Thank you.

25 (Applause.)

1 MR. PETRACCO: Okay. Now, we're going to move on
2 to the statements by the governing body. I think we'll just
3 go in order.

4 Dr. Joe?

5 MR. SCARPELLI: Mayor, fellow commissioners,
6 honored guests, Reverend Clergy, first thing I'd like to
7 thank is my committee for the hard work that they've done.
8 You know, it was a long campaign, and they worked very hard,
9 all the campaign fund raisers and our events, and I -- I
10 can't say enough.

11 I don't want to mention you individually. I'll
12 leave somebody out, but I want to thank you.

13 My family -- you know, for us to do this takes a
14 lot of hard work on our family. We -- we sacrifice -- they
15 sacrifice a lot for us to do this.

16 My wife, Sue, thank you. She knows Route 80 in
17 and out, up to Penn State, Scranton. You know
18 -- she knows the rest stops. She knows the gas stations.
19 So if you ever have any problems, see her.

20 Thank you, Honey. I appreciate everything you do.

21 (Applause.è

22 MR. SCARPELLI: My son, Sal -- he put all the
23 media together, all the brochures, FaceBook page, Web site,
24 tremendous asset. I'm so proud of him.

25 Sal.

1 (Applause.)

2 MR. SCARPELLI: My daughter, Ariel (ph) -- she
3 just graduated Penn State. She's going to graduate school
4 at Rutgers. I'm so proud of her, too, and she's here today.

5 Ari.

6 (Applause.)

7 MR. SCARPELLI: My daughter Gianna's (ph) taking
8 finals at University of Scranton, so she couldn't be here
9 today, and she worked the FaceBook page. She was on there
10 all the time liking everything we did and really worked out
11 great.

12 My mom and dad -- what can I say? Thank you.

13 (Applause.)

14 MR. SCARPELLI: My nephew, Anthony, was out there
15 pressing the flesh, getting us votes.

16 Thank you, Anthony.

17 (Applause.)

18 MR. SCARPELLI: My Uncle Ralph and Uncle Vito --
19 they stayed all day outside Lincoln School, all day long,
20 and the votes came in at Lincoln School, as they always do.
21 Thank you

22 (Applause.)

23 MR. SCARPELLI: All my cousins -- they took the
24 day off, and they helped us on the campaign, and they were
25 there at every meeting. So I thank them, too.

1 (Applause.)

2 MR. SCARPELLI: Congratulations to our new mayor,
3 Al Petracco, our new commissioner, Steve Rogers, and my
4 fellow commissioners that I've had the privilege of serving
5 over the last four years.

6 I want to also thank Sam Flitel (ph), John Kufone
7 (ph), Fred Scalari (ph), Ken Riley (ph) for their time and
8 efforts. This was the best group of candidates we've had in
9 a long time.

10 This campaign was really long. Only two months
11 ago, the first of many, many signs started going up, and let
12 me tell you I promise you that the sign ordinance will be
13 one of the first orders of business of this new Board of
14 Commissioners.

15 (Applause.)

16 MR. SCARPELLI: So the signs are -- signs are
17 going up, and Tony Menacco (ph) and my father come to my
18 office, and I start telling them, "I want this sign over
19 here. I want it faced that way. I want it faced this way."
20 They look at me like I have two heads. Said we've been
21 doing this for 50 years. You can't tell us what to do.

22 You know, they have been doing this for 50 years.
23 My grandfather first ran in 1964, and those two guys were
24 working there. They worked all through my father's
25 campaigns, and I got to tell you, you know, my grandfather

1 ran four times. My father served 24 years, and they were
2 both an inspiration. And to have my father here is very
3 special, and I know my grandfather's here also.

4 Gramp, 13 votes. Come on.

5 (Laughter.ə)

6 (Applause.ə)

7 MR. SCARPELLI: But things happen for reasons.

8 You know, during the campaign, at one of the forums, we were
9 asked by someone who didn't grow up here, "Well, what makes
10 Nutley special"? Well, it didn't take long. I answered the
11 park oval (ph)e Not only does it sit in the center of our
12 town, a very Norman Rockwell setting, surrounded by the town
13 hall, Nutley High School, the junior high school, public
14 safety building, the library, it's also the heart and soul
15 of our community.

16 Much of our lives, as either children or adults,
17 revolve around the oval. Saturday high school football
18 games, Sunday junior Raider games, soccer games. Columbus
19 Day parade ends there, the Nutley/Belleville Thanksgiving
20 Day game, which we'll be losing soon, but we gave back Santa
21 Claus coming in the helicopter, a tree-lighting ceremony,
22 St. Patrick's Day parade, baseball, lacrosse, Memorial Day
23 parade, Junior Olympics, middle school graduation, high
24 school graduation, American Legion and the 4th of July. So
25 much of our lives are involved with the oval.

1 One of the things that makes Nutley special --
2 well, that's also unique. Keeping these traditions and
3 keeping Nutley as much as it was like when we grew up is why
4 I love serving this position.

5 During our first summer we accomplished much.
6 You've heard this all before. Cut the DPW four times. We
7 were challenged by the weather, microburst storm blizzards
8 of 2000, 2010, Hurricane Irene, snowtober storm and this
9 year we figured out how to stop it from snowing altogether.

10 One more time Al?

11 MR. PETRACCO: No gain, no laugh.

12 (Laughter.)

13 MR. SCARPELLI: Much has been accomplished. Much
14 work needs to be done. Campaigns are over. Time to get
15 back to the business of governing.

16 We have many challenges facing us. Decreased
17 rateables, especially at Hoffmann LaRoche, the need for
18 smart development on that property, the continued
19 revitalization of our downtown. These are big issues that
20 need big ideas. I am very excited about being here for
21 another four years to help contribute to those ideas.

22 Thank you for the honor and privilege of serving
23 the people of Nutley. Thank you.

24 (Applause.)

25 MR. SCARPELLI: Thank you. Thank you.

1 MR. PETRACCOe Well said, Commissioner Scarpelli.
2 Now, we'll move on to Commissioner Rogers.

3 MR. ROGERSe Ladies and gentlemen, when
4 Chief Holland walked in tonighte I looked at him, and I
5 said, "Well, we've come a long way since being a patrolman
6 on the corner of Franklin and Center,e and that's what makes
7 America great. We can start somewhere. Maybe we feel
8 insignificante and then suddenlye by the grace of God -- and
9 I certainly give God all the glory tonighte todaye because
10 it was through his guidance and grace and his love and his
11 strength that I'm here today.

12 I'd like to thank my lovely wifee Natasha, who
13 walked a million miles with me, and we walked. We walked
14 through every neighborhood of the township. My mom, Ann,
15 who -- Monsignoree I must confess to you now she nearly
16 burned your church down lighting enough candles.

17 My daughter, Crystal, my son, Stevene who's here
18 with the newest addition to the family. He's been a good
19 boy, by the way. Proud of my son. He was a Marine in Iraq,
20 and he is here today. Thank you.

21 (Applause.e)

22 MR. ROGERS: Well, we've come a long way. And the
23 United States Navy and in the Nutley Police Department after
24 38 years, I've learned one word that's so important to all
25 of us, and that's teamwork.

1 Mayor, you've got a new team member here.

2 (Indiscernible) myself to your success, the success of all
3 my colleagues for the common good of the people, and as I
4 remarked earlier to Monsignor Ernie, there's a scripture in
5 the Bible that says, "To whom much is given, much is
6 expected." I will live up to your expectations.

7 Thank you. God bless you, and God bless America.

8 (Applause.)

9 MR. ROGERS: I forgot two important people.

10 Charlie Tedesco (ph) and his wife, Enid (ph)t

11 (Applause.)

12 MR. ROGERS: Forgive me for forgetting you. I'm a
13 little nervous.

14 But Charlie Tedesco, as my mother says, the two
15 most unlikely characters on the face of the Earth came
16 together. Charlie Tedesco and his wife walked every
17 neighborhood from 5:00 in the morning to 6:00 at night with
18 me and my wife. I learned that he's a -- kind of a world-
19 class boxing coach. I learned real quick what it meant to
20 be in the ring with him.

21 But, Charlie, love you like a brother. God bless
22 you, and thank you so much.

23 (Applause.t)

24 MR. PETRACCO: Mr. Evans?

25 MR. EVANS: Thank you, Mayor.

1 I've completed nine years as a commissioner, and
2 one of the things I've -- I've recognized over that nine-
3 year period is my work never seems to be done. There's
4 always something to do. This was a very difficult election,
5 and you can't be a commissioner unless you have a great
6 support structure around you.

7 I want to thank my family. I want to thank
8 members of my -- my campaign committee, who -- in actually,
9 working through the election, we became good friends, which
10 I -- I value greatly. So, in time of political actions, you
11 can forge friendships. I think that's a great
12 accomplishment and something that I'm -- I'm pleased about.

13 As I think about where we are and the work that we
14 have to do, we're managing our way through a perfect storm.
15 And, if you all remember, you know, some of the movie
16 endings, they were pretty tragic, but in Nutley, our -- our
17 ending is absolutely going to be a happy ending. We've done
18 quite a bit to stabilize our cost structure, make sure we
19 have the ability to invest where we need to invest and how
20 to prioritize those investments for the best advantage of --
21 of the township.

22 But, when I think about my role and I think about
23 where we're going, I've been spending a lot of time
24 remembering our town fathers and going back to a day when
25 they had the vision which actually created our parks system,

1 the Yanticaw River and the park system that runs through our
2 township didn't happen by accident. It was actually by the
3 vision of our town fathers to get that established.

4 This complex that we're in, the building that
5 we're in -- purchased from the Duncan Essex Mill in 1892 for
6 \$15,000 and actually established this center as our -- the
7 center of our town, and the oval itself and the buildings
8 around here used to be mill property that was now converted
9 into the center.

10 So it's my hope that as we think about
11 revitalization of our downtown, how we look at the -- the
12 next generation of residents and how we serve them -- well,
13 I can only hope that I can begin to have their vision and
14 actually live by a standard that they've created, and it's
15 my hope that after nine years maybe -- maybe in this next
16 term I'll have the ability to attain that.

17 So I want to thank my fellow commissioners for
18 rejoining them.

19 Mayor, congratulations.

20 Steve, welcome aboard. We have a lot of work to
21 do and I look forward to serving with you. Thank you.

22 (Applause.)

23 MR. PETRACCO: Well-done.

24 Commissioner Tucci?

25 MR. TUCCI: Yes, thank you, Mayor.

1 Reverend Clergy, distinguished guests, colleagues,
2 and friends, I'd like to begin today by congratulating all
3 of my colleagues up here for having the strength and the
4 fortitude to go through an election, to conduct an election
5 in the manner and the fashion that we did, and I'd also like
6 to congratulate all of the candidates who ran for office.
7 You know, it takes a lot to put yourself out there, because
8 you're not representing a company. You're not representing
9 an organization. You're representing yourself and your
10 ideas and your ideals and what you believe in. So I want to
11 congratulate everyone for that.

12 I'd like to thank the people of Nutley for having
13 the trust and faith in me to elect me to a fourth term. I'm
14 very honored for the privilege to continue serving. It is
15 something I'll never forget.

16 You know, being a commissioner takes a lot of time
17 and a lot of dedication, and that also means a lot of time
18 away from your family. So, at this time, I'd like to thank
19 my immediate family, my wife, Linda, my daughter, Gina, my
20 Josephine, Gerard, Clifford, Ryan and our newest Nutley
21 resident and citizen, Lucia, who's taking a nap on Gina's
22 shoulder as we speak.

23 (Applause.ø

24 MR. TUCCI: I'd like to thank my brothers and
25 sisters, my sister-in-laws, my brother-in-laws, my nieces,

1 my nephews, and everyone that was involved with the
2 campaign. There are way too many of them to even begin to
3 try to name them all.

4 As you know, there's always one person that stands
5 out, and that person for me is my brother, Gerard, who is
6 wise beyond his years. He's not only my brother and my
7 partner, but he's also my friend, and I'd like to thank him
8 for everything.

9 (Applause.)

10 MR. TUCCI: And then, along the lines of friends,
11 my treasurer, my friend from when my children first attended
12 Yantacaw School, Jim Callahan.

13 I don't know if you're here, but wherever you are,
14 thank you for your friendship, and thank you for all the
15 help that you've given me over this past 12 years. Thank
16 you so much.

17 (Applause.)

18 MR. TUCCI: My parks department family -- and we
19 are truly, truly a family. We love each other. We hate
20 each other. We fight with each other. We kiss and make up,
21 and then, we move on.

22 I'd like to thank each and every one of them for
23 working so well together and with all the other departments,
24 not only to save the town money, but to ultimately get the
25 job done, and they get the job done for us each and every

1 day, and I know they're going to continue to do that. Thank
2 you very much

3 (Applause.)

4 Today I want to make a pledge to you that
5 together, this Board of Commissioners will continue all the
6 good work that started many, many years ago and that I in
7 particular have started over the past 12 years in the parks
8 department. I look forward to serving in the coming four
9 years, and I know that together, we're going to assure that
10 Nutley continues to be the wonderful community that it is.
11 Thank you very much.

12 (Applause.)

13 MR. PETRACCO: Thank you, Commissioner.

14 I would like to first start to say campaigns bring
15 a lot of separation, and today is a new day, and I could
16 assure you that this Board of Commissioners is -- are
17 united, and we are very friendly as well, and we'll move --
18 we will move this town forward, and I'd like to be clear and
19 say it's not about any of us. It's not about being called
20 mayor, commissioner. It's about all of you.

21 We worked very diligently together to make a
22 difference in this town. We give up a lot of time. We all
23 have that in common. We're never home for our families.
24 We're never at our businesses, hardly, but we do it because
25 we all care about the town very, very much. So we have that

1 one thing in common.

2 So I'd just like to clear up one thing that
3 Commissioner Scarpelli said, although he was a true, true
4 friend of mine and gentleman.

5 It was 14 votes, Joe, not 13.

6 (Laughter.)

7 (Applause.)

8 MR. PETRACCO: I can't talk enough about Joe, and
9 I will -- I will call him at a title (ph). Joe has been a
10 friend of mine, a supporter of mine for many, many years.
11 My political career started very, very long ago with my good
12 friend, Gary Marino (ph), that I was working in the deli,
13 and Gary dragged me to one of Joe's freeholder (ph) events.

14 If it wasn't for that, Joe, I might not even be
15 here. So thank you.

16 Steve Rogers -- again, we worked very hard
17 together in public safety. We didn't always agree, but at
18 the end of the day, we were always talking about the issue
19 and how we make Nutley a better place.

20 Steve, I know you'll be a great commissioner. I
21 know your heart's in the right place, and I'm glad you're
22 here.

23 Tom, Tom Evans -- not many people know this, but
24 Kenny Evans -- and I don't see him here today, Tom. Is he
25 here?

1 UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: (Indiscernible.)

2 MR. PETRACCO: Okay. Well, Kenny is a good friend
3 of the Petracco family. When Kenny said that Tom was his
4 brother, I almost fell over, because it's true they're very
5 opposite, but they have one thing in common. They're very
6 loyal people. And I can assure you that Tom's been very
7 loyal to me in my journey of being a commissioner.

8 And what you did, Tom, helping me along the way --
9 Joanne's in the back. Success doesn't happen by accident.
10 It's hard work, and it's surrounding yourself by good
11 people. So thank Tom, and I'd like to thank Joanne as well.

12 (Applause.)

13 MR. PETRACCO: Mauro Tucci is the kind of guy that
14 I like to hang around with. He's a lot of fun. He has a
15 lot of wisdom, and he has a lot of friends. I have to tell
16 you, Mauro has helped me immensely from day one.

17 He's always been that person that I could pick up
18 the phone, call him. If we had a disagreement or not, he
19 always took my call. A lot of his family members are very
20 close friends of the Petracco family.

21 And I could just say this, Mauro, out loud.
22 You're a good friend of mine. It could have been any one of
23 us up here sitting in this seat. So again, thank you for
24 all your help, and most of all, your friendship. Thank you.

25 (Applause.)

1 MR. PETRACCO: Now, I'm going to do something that
2 Al Petracco very seldom does. I'm going to read a speech
3 and not talk from my heart.

4 This morning, I was practicing my speech, and my
5 son, Salvatore, my four-year-old, said, "Dad, you're waking
6 me up. What are you doing? Practicing your speech?" And I
7 said, "Yes, Sal." I said, "How do you like it?" He said,
8 "I loved it." So hopefully, you will, too.

9 First, I would like to thank my wife, Fran, my
10 three sons, Sonny, Vincent, Salvatore. I love you very
11 much. There is nothing in life that means more to me than
12 you, all of you.

13 I would like to thank my mom and dad and all their
14 friends who have been great inspirations to me my whole
15 life, and you have always taught me right from wrong. I
16 would like to thank my two brothers and my sister-in-law,
17 Tracy, for stepping up and joining in on my journey.

18 At this time, I have to thank and congratulate my
19 campaign committee. The list is too long to mention names.
20 It has been a lot of fun, hard work, and commitment. Thank
21 you all.

22 I would also like to thank everyone from public
23 safety. Again, the list is too long to mention names. We
24 have a great team, and each and every one of you have done
25 an excellent job.

1 I would also like to say thank you to all of our
2 volunteers, especially the fire and our great ambulance
3 squad up the street. I would like to thank our honorary
4 judge, Joanne Cocchiola and the Board of Commissioners for
5 welcoming me to the Board of -- to the board four years ago.
6 I could have done it without each and every one of you.

7 I would also like to welcome Steve Rogers and wish
8 you a lot of luck the next four years. I know you will do a
9 great job.

10 I just want to say thank you to all my grammar
11 school friends that are here today. Although it seems like
12 yesterday we all started kindergarten at Washington School,
13 it has been many years ago.

14 I would also like to thank my high school friends,
15 the class of 198~~8~~. Thanks for coming out today.

16 For those of you who don't know me, I've always
17 been blessed to have a lot of best friends. I have a long
18 list here, guys, that I've been adding onto today, so I'm
19 not going to mention any of you. You know who you are.

20 Unfortunately, this past October~~e~~ my best friend
21 passed away suddenly at the age of 52 from a heart attack.
22 it wasn't a big surprise to any of us. Big wasn't a word to
23 describe him. You see, he was well over 400 pounds. We all
24 called him Puffy for obvious reasons. You leave the guy at
25 my house helping my wife set up for parties when I couldn't

1 be there.

2 (Pause.)

3 One day shortly before he died, I said to him,
4 "Puffy, I have to be nuts for getting involved in these
5 politics. All you do is fight with everyone, make enemies,
6 and open yourself to criticism." Looking him in his eye,
7 waiting for his response, I thought he was going to say, "I
8 told you so." Instead, he said to me, "You have to do it,"
9 very sternly. He said, "Who else would represent the
10 average person"? Those words have stuck in my head.

11 As I look back in history, haven't our past town
12 fathers, great leaders have done, just that? Lucy (ph)
13 Scarpelli, Chenowith, Frank Cocchiola, Carmen Araccio (ph)
14 and my good friend, Mr. Kelly. They all have -- they have
15 all represented the average person. So I will heed those
16 words and dedicate my next four years to all the average
17 people who live in this town, who get up day in, day out, go
18 to work to struggle to keep their families in Nutley. I
19 will work tireless to make Nutley affordable for all of you.

20 As I said four years ago, I will let my actions
21 speak for myself. On behalf of the Board of Commissioners,
22 God bless you. God bless our town. Thank you for coming.

23 (Applause.)

24 MR. PETRACCO: Reminder -- our next Board of
