
WHEREAS, funds are available from CDBG funding Account # T-19-909-902 and have been certified by the Chief Financial Officer, said certification being attached to this resolution; and

Drivers and helper inspect trucks every morning, checking oil or broken lenses. When work is needed, the trucks are turned over to your Mechanics' Department for service.



No other person shall be permitted to park in these spaces.
