## Ordinance # 3176

ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE FUNDING OF CONTRACTUALLY REQUIRED SEVERANCE LIABILITIES RESULTING FROM THE RETIREMENT OF EMPLOYEES, IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF NUTLEY, IN THE COUNTY OF ESSEX, NEW JERSEY, APPROPRIATING \$500,000 THEREFOR

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NUTLEY, IN THE COUNTY OF ESSEX, NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The purpose described in Section 2 of this ordinance is hereby authorized to be undertaken by the Township of Nutley, New Jersey. For the purpose described in Section 2, there is hereby appropriated \$500,000, to be received after the issuance of special emergency notes.

Section 2. (a) The purpose hereby authorized is the funding of contractually required severance liabilities for retiring employees in the Township of Nutley pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53, all as on file with the Township Clerk.

(b) The estimated cost of the purpose is equal to the amount of the appropriation herein made therefor.

Section 3. The capital budget of the Township of Nutley is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. The resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services is on file with the Clerk, and is available there for public inspection.

Section 4. \$500,000 to be received from the issuance of special emergency notes is hereby appropriated for the purpose set forth in Section 2 hereof and shall be applied to the direct payment of the cost of such purpose.

Section 5. A copy of this ordinance as adopted shall be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect in accordance with law.
