RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NUTLEY TO OPPOSE THE TRANSCONTINENTAL GAS PIPELINE COMPANY'S NORTHEAST SUPPLY LINE

WHEREAS, Transcontinental Gas Pipeline Company (Transco), a subsidiary of the Williams Company, is proposing an expansion project throughout areas of Pennsylvania and New Jersey, including the uprate of the existing pipeline that runs through the Township of Nutley; and

WHEREAS, the Township previously objected in 1998-1999 to an expansion project when it was proposed, to replace the gas line that ran through the Township as it was presented as aging pipe with questionable integrity; and

WHEREAS, it has been represented that the current and proposed project will increase the capacity of the existing line by 13% from 638 psi to 722 psi, which is half of the maximum design pressure and the maximum psi allowed by law; and

WHEREAS, residents here, and in other impacted areas in New Jersey, have expressed opposition to the project based on safety concerns, its potential harm to municipal and county infrastructure and its potential impact on the value of homes in an already depressed housing market; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners joins with the residents of the Township in questioning the safety and reliability of the aging pipes and is concerned about the hazards increased pressure and testing could present to the approximately 1700 residents who live within 300 feet of the line, some within mere feet of the line; and

WHEREAS, the Board is concerned about other reported gas pipeline explosions in Edison and Bernards Township in New Jersey as well as in other areas of the country, including Pennsylvania, Ohio, Minnesota, Maryland and Texas; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners believe it is its responsibility to provide a safe environment for its residents and this proposal, as well as the proposed testing raise serious safety concerns for the people of this township; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Commissioners have filed comments with the Federal Energy and Regulatory Commission objecting to the project, a copy of what is annexed hereto;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Board of Commissioners oppose the Northeast Supply Link Expansion project proposed by Transco, in particular, the uprate of the existing pipeline segments that run through the Township of Nutley; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Board of Commissioners object to the proposed "smart pig" testing scheduled to occur this year and will not accept testing through this municipality without the company bearing the expense for emergency and fire service and backup as well as appropriate equipment, including a foam truck to prevent any incident that could occur as a result of a gas leak or fire.

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NUTLEY
TO OPPOSE THE TRANSCONTINENTAL GAS PIPELINE COMPANY'S
NORTHEAST SUPPLY LINE**

WHEREAS, Transcontinental Gas Pipeline Company (Transco), a subsidiary of the Williams Company, is proposing an expansion project throughout areas of Pennsylvania and New Jersey, including the uprate of the existing pipeline that runs through the Township of Nutley; and

WHEREAS, the Township previously objected in 1998-1999 to an expansion project when it was proposed, to replace the gas line that ran through the Township as it was presented as aging pipe with questionable integrity; and

WHEREAS, it has been represented that the current and proposed project will increase the capacity of the existing line by 13% from 638 psi to 722 psi, which is half of the maximum design pressure and the maximum psi allowed by law; and

WHEREAS, residents here, and in other impacted areas in New Jersey, have expressed opposition to the project based on safety concerns, its potential harm to municipal and county infrastructure and its potential impact on the value of homes in an already depressed housing market; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners joins with the residents of the Township in questioning the safety and reliability of the aging pipes and is concerned about the hazards increased pressure and testing could present to the approximately 1700 residents who live within 300 feet of the line, some within mere feet of the line; and

WHEREAS, the Board is concerned about other reported gas pipeline explosions in Edison and Bernards Township in New Jersey as well as in other areas of the country, including Pennsylvania, Ohio, Minnesota, Maryland and Texas; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners believe it is its responsibility to provide a safe environment for its residents and this proposal, as well as the proposed testing raise serious safety concerns for the people of this township; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Commissioners have filed comments with the Federal Energy and Regulatory Commission objecting to the project, a copy of what is annexed hereto;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Board of Commissioners oppose the Northeast Supply Link Expansion project proposed by Transco, in particular, the uprate of the existing pipeline segments that run through the Township of Nutley; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Board of Commissioners object to the proposed "smart pig" testing scheduled to occur this year and will not accept testing through this municipality without the company bearing the expense for emergency and fire service and backup as well as appropriate equipment, including a foam truck to prevent any incident that could occur as a result of a gas leak or fire.
