Unless further time is granted by the Board, each person shall limit their address to five (5) minutes. All remarks to the Board and its individual members must be addressed to the Mayor. The Mayor may defer citizen comments to the appropriate member of the Board. Dialogue between citizens and others addressing the Board shall be allowed unless the Mayor, or presiding officer, or the majority of the membership of the Board, shall determine that the interests of decorum and/or the expeditious conduct of municipal business are being adversely affected by such dialogue.

Rory W. Moore, 462 Chestnut Street, Asked why in paragraph three of resolution number 322-09 indicate "Pennoni Engineering, Inc., the Township Engineering Company" and not a different engineering company. Commissioner Tucci responded and stated Pennoni was retained for the previous study and he felt that it was prudent that the same engineering company conduct this updated study as well.

Robert Iacobucci, 41 Cathedral Avenue, Asked if resolution number 339-09 indicated a \$25,000.00 transaction to insure a roof. Commissioner Tucci responded and stated no, that the \$25,000.00 is part of a transfer of appropriations (2009 budget).

Mr. Iacobucci asked is the township researched and compared prices for the purchase of a bus, Commissioner Tucci responded and stated that the Bidding process was used in order to award the contract. The contract was awarded to the lowest bidder as indicated in resolution number 321-09

Mr. lacobucci asked Commissioner Petracco how many paid firemen are in the Township of Nutley and asked how i it possible that many other municipalities can provide the same level of service with volunteer firefighters only. Commissioner Petracco responded and stated that the Township has thirty-seven (37) paid firefighters and that every municipality has different needs and that the Township of Nutley has a need for paid firefighters along with volunteer firefighters.
