AMVETS has owned it since property. 1967, and prior to our town's explosion as far as growth goes, we used to use it for the town's picnics, until ITT let us use the bigger property because we got bigger and bigger. Fortunately, we kept the property. At one point, Mr. Cocchiola and myself, Mr. Orechio and Mr. Kelly tried to make it into a veterans' home set up in there, but the town turned it -- the board turned it down as far as homes go. So that's water under the bridge. Subsequently, we have been taking care of it for the past fifty years, or forty years, in the form of letting the neighbors use it for their children, et cetera, et cetera. We pay the insurance on it, we take care of it, and at this point, it's become a burden

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Nutley Twp Board of Commissioners - 9/16/08 and we don't want to sell it, we don't want to give it to anybody, we want to hold on to it for the sole purpose of having a school parking lot to an addition to what we have. What we have, if you look on the map, is a problem. And I've given you a map, survey. There's a garage on our property. These people have been informed since 1980 to remove it, whoever was there at that There's a fence with a couple of point. put -- couple animals there that don't belong there. Fortunately, there was something up above in the corner, it says 140, it's north 24, east 30. There used to be a building outside there, but the person took it down. Whoever had it there took it down.

In 1900 when I was the commander, I had this survey done. The original survey is here, all right, and we informed the people that had the things to remove them. They did. This gentleman removed his and this gentleman

I'm back, I'm the commander again, and we've got this situation with this garage there. Now, we want to put a gravel parking lot. We are doing a lot of work with the Department of Military Affairs with men coming in with -- we have two meetings a week, all right? for instance, this coming month, we have a meeting where we're going to give out a hundred diplomas to veterans from Vietnam and World War II, and the parking lot that we have is too small because we try to accommodate our neighbors. All right? Our neighbors on Walnut Street don't have enough parking in their houses, so they come up and they park in our lot, which is okay, we don't mind. But now comes a time when we have to expand. And we are going to expand. But I want you to see I've already talked what's on that map. to Public Works. If you'll notice on the second page, there's a tree thing. Ιn

Nutley Twp Board of Commissioners - 9/16/08 that section, we have no intentions of cutting trees along the railroad, no intention of cutting any trees out along the property line of the people that live behind us, our neighbors. The only ones we're going to have to take down, and with an approval, is the inside trees. That's all we want to do. So far, we've been very fortunate. We have a very good neighbor, Linda Frank, who's been with us ever since day one. They come in there, they clean it up, bulldoze it, and it's going to cost me four containers to take the garbage that's out there, including dumpsters -- not dumpsters, refrigerators and other stuff like that.

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I would like these commissioners, here, to realize what we're trying to do and get on somebody's case because it's going nowhere at this point. It happened before the election, if you remember, and now it has gone nowhere. And I am getting static from my members and I'm getting static from other people I

Nutley Twp Board of Commissioners - 9/16/08 1 2 shouldn't be getting it from. 3 MAYOR COCCHIOLA: Mr. Magnifico, what is it you're asking us to do? 4 5 MR. MAGNIFICO: I am asking you to 6 somehow get the Building Department --7 all right, it's not your fault, the 8 Building Department's fault. I know the 9 people haven't given you their survey to 10 show you that they're illegally on our 11 property. Because my people want to sue I don't want to do that. I just 12 them. want them to get off. All right? 13 14 COMMISSIONER EVANS: Jack, my 15 understanding is through the Code 16 Department, they've sent the property 17 owners letters --18 MR. MAGNIFICO: I know they did. 19 COMMISSIONER EVANS: -- informing 20 them that they're encroaching on the 21 property. 22 MR. MAGNIFICO: One of my members --23 COMMISSIONER EVANS: There's a 24 question of whether they are or they 25 aren't. I've seen the survey tonight for Nutley Twp Board of Commissioners - 9/16/08 the first time, right, so there could be an issue between boundaries. I'm not saying there are --

MR. MAGNIFICO: I know.

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COMMISSIONER EVANS: -- but that has to follow its course. So in the Building Department, I've asked them to draw it for clarity around the property line, whether or not there is an encroachment, right, whether or not permits have been taken out to construct whatever has been constructed there. And if there is a violation, they'll be noticed, the owners will be noticed. If it has to come down, ultimately, that's what we'll do, if that's, you know, if the fact is that between property owners there can't be an agreement reached to allow for an encroachment if one exists. the fire department has been exempt.

I've spoken to our police department. It
amazes me that we have our police
department go through drug testing, but
for some reason, the fire department or

included in this. I know, Mr. Petracco,
this is not something that you did.

COMMISSIONER PETRACCO: No, like I have been saying, that we are coming into new negotiations and contracts this year, and it's no secret that we are definitely looking to implicate something on the fire side.
