    MADAM CLERK: Commissioner Tucci?
    COMMISSIONER TUCCI: Here.
    MADAM CLERK: Commissioner Evans is
    absent/excused.
    MADAM CLERK: Commissioner Petracco?
    COMMISSIONER PETRACCO: Here.
    MADAM CLERK: Mayor Scarpelli?
    MAYOR SCARPELLI: Here.
    MADAM CLERK: Thank you, Mayor. All present,
    except for Commissioner Rogers and Commissioner Evans. They
    are absent/excused.
    MAYOR SCARPELLI: Okay. Go around the horn.
    Commissioner Petracco?
    COMMISSIONER PETRACCO: I have an ordinance

introduction for a handicapped spot.
Where is that (indiscernible)?
Oh, I have an introduction for a handicapped spot.
I'll read it into the record wherever it is.

I have a proclamation.
MADAM CLERK: A resolution, Commissioner.
COMMISSIONER PETRACCO: Oh, is it a resolution?

MADAM CLERK: Yes, we changed it.
SANDRA CARELLA: Yeah, I'm sorry. We changed it.

COMMISSIONER PETRACCO: Okay.
SANDRA CARELLA: I'm sorry.

COMMISSIONER PETRACCO: I don't even see my name on it, so --

MADAM CLERK: Yes, you are.
COMMISSIONER PETRACCO: Here we go. So it's a resolution that says proclamation October 6th for Knockout Opiate Abuse Day, which is Thursday, Sam?

SANDRA CARELLA: Uh-huh.

SANDRA CARELLA: October 6th.

COMMISSIONER PETRACCO: And I believe it was what I'm handing in all the -- your medications and all that stuff. Is that -- are we doing that at the police department this Thursday?

UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: Uh-huh.

UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: No, that's the 22 nd. COMMISSIONER PETRACCO: Okay.
(Pause)
MAYOR SCARPELLI: That's it?
COMMISSIONER PETRACCO: That's all I have. MAYOR SCARPELLI: Commissioner Tucci?

COMMISSIONER TUCCI: I have an award of contract to John Linson, who is our township forester for an amount not to exceed 22,000. I have an award of contract to PrimePoint, LLC. They do our ACA reporting. I have to amend the resolution, because $I$-- the wording wasn't 100 percent correct.

MADAM CLERK: Sorry.
COMMISSIONER TUCCI: That's okay. I don't think it was your fault.

MADAM CLERK: It wasn't.
COMMISSIONER TUCCI: What you're saying is
(indiscernible).
(Laughter)
COMMISSIONER TUCCI: I think it was our people. I
think we paraphrased it. They wanted something different. FRANK DEMAIO: Yeah, they wanted -- yeah, because
they --
COMMISSIONER TUCCI: They wanted it exact. So -which they usually don't. But what are you going to do?

Somebody made (indiscernible).
And I have a refund of a tree permit for Donald Beesley at 27 Sylvan Place. That's it.

MAYOR SCARPELLI: Thank you, Commissioner.
COMMISSIONER TUCCI: You're welcome.
MAYOR SCARPELLI: Well, we have an ordinance
introduction on behalf of all of us for the salary ordinance, which I'll introduce. And I have an authorization to go out for bids for the multi-space parking stations, which are in the parking lots. Not related to the ones that we have demonstrated.

COMMISSIONER TUCCI: Oh, it's not those?
MAYOR SCARPELLI: No.
COMMISSIONER TUCCI: Okay.
MAYOR SCARPELLI: And an authorize to approve various raffle license applications.

Commissioner Rogers has the appointment of Michele Schiber?

MADAM CLERK: Schiber, yes.
MAYOR SCARPELLI: As the animal cruelty
investigator. And recognizing October as Breast Cancer Awareness Month.

Commissioner Evans has rescinding a resolution.
Do we know what that resolution was?
MADAM CLERK: Yes, the resolution is for our tax
assessor, because Ms. Durkin (ph) wanted specific wording, just like the grant.

MAYOR SCARPELLI: Okay.
COMMISSIONER TUCCI: There you go.

MADAM CLERK: So we are going to rescind that one and read into the record --

MAYOR SCARPELLI: The new one?

MADAM CLERK: -- a new one.
MAYOR SCARPELLI: Okay.
MADAM CLERK: The new one only says that he's -he has to fulfill the first term before he gets appointed for the four years.

MAYOR SCARPELLI: And would appoint Edmund
Benjamin Brown to the part-time tax assessor.
UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: Okay.

MAYOR SCARPELLI: Commissioner, would you do Commissioner Rogers'?

COMMISSIONER TUCCI: Sure, I'd love to.
MAYOR SCARPELLI: Commissioner, would you do Commissioner Evans'?

COMMISSIONER PETRACCO: Sure.

MAYOR SCARPELLI: All right. That'll make it easy. Put them in order.

Madam Clerk, do you have anything on the agenda? MADAM CLERK: I just wanted to tell you that $I$ did
put into the newspaper for the change of date for November from the 15 th to the 22 nd and that Surrogate Stevens (ph) is coming the next meeting on October 18th.

MAYOR SCARPELLI: The contract negotiations. COMMISSIONER TUCCI: Prism's going to be outside? MR. GENITEMPO: Yes.

COMMISSIONER TUCCI: Prism's outside?

MAYOR SCARPELLI: Outside.
COMMISSIONER TUCCI: Okay.
COMMISSIONER PETRACCO: Well, if we're going to do
that at 7:30, you want to just do it now?
