ORDINANCE NO. 2014-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST WINDSOR, IN THE COUNTY OF MERCER, NEW JERSEY, REAPPROPRIATING \$144,000 PROCEEDS OF OBLIGATIONS NOT NEEDED FOR THEIR ORIGINAL PURPOSES TO PROVIDE FOR UPGRADE AND/OR REPLACEMENT OF EQUIPMENT AND ANNUAL ROAD PROGRAM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST WINDSOR, IN THE COUNTY OF MERCER, NEW JERSEY (by not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:2-39, it is hereby determined that \$144,000 of the proceeds of obligations originally made available pursuant to Section 3(a) Bond Ordinance 1994 -30 of the Township of East Windsor, in the County of Mercer, New Jersey (the "Township"), finally adopted November 1, 1994, are no longer necessary to build a new office building at Ward Street.


Section 2. The \$144,000 proceeds described in Section 1 and made available pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:2-39 are hereby re-appropriated to provide \$84,000 for Upgrade and/or Replacement of Equipment and \$60,000 for Annual Road Program.

Section 3. The Township hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a temporary capital budget, as applicable. The capital budget or temporary capital budget of the Township of East Windsor is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised capital or temporary capital budget has been filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provide by law.




