

- **KINNELON ENVIRONMENTAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE MINUTES**
AUGUST 30, 2018

MEETING TO ORDER:

Chairperson Lisa Donnelly Hankes stated this meeting is being held pursuant to the New Jersey Open Public Meeting Act.
