- 2. I will do my best to make sports FUN for my child.
- 3. I will remember that the game is for the youth, not adults.
- 4. I will be a respectful fan.
- 5. I will be respectful of and support coaches and officials working with my child.
- 6. I will refrain from criticizing the opponents and will be positive with all players.
- 7. I will not coach my child or any other child during games.
- 8. I will help the coach accomplish team goals.
- 9. I will show respect for all referees. They may make mistakes, but they are doing their best.
- 10. I will let the coach control the game.
- 11. I realize that this is an instructional league, we do not keep standings.
