## RESOLUTION NO. 2016-05

**A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2015-16 WHICH TEMPORARILY SET ASIDE THE STANDING COMMITTEES AS PROVIDED FOR IN THE DOVER CODE AND ENACTED A COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE ON A TRIAL BASIS**

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 2015-16, adopted by City Council on December 14, 2015, temporarily set aside the Standing Committees as provided for in the Dover Code and enacted a Committee of the Whole on a temporary basis; and

**WHEREAS**, City Council wishes for members of City Council and the civilian members of the Parks, Recreation, and Community Enhancement; Safety Advisory and Transportation; Utility; and Legislative, Finance, and Administration committees to continue meeting as a Council Committee of the Whole on the second and fourth Tuesdays of the month through May 31, 2017.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DOVER, IN COUNCIL MET:**

**THAT** the last paragraph of Resolution No. 2015-16 be amended to read as follows:

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council and civilian members of the Standing Committees will act as a Council Committee of the Whole, meeting on the second and fourth Tuesdays of the month through May 31, 2017. If Council chooses to adopt this meeting format, an Ordinance amendment regarding the Standing Committees will be presented for adoption prior to the Annual Meeting in May.
