Perza was appointed to serve on the Compensation Commission on May 9, 2011, serving in that position until May 17, 2013, and was appointed to the Salary and Benefits Compensation Comparison Committee on August 22, 2011 and served as Chair of that Committee until September 10, 2012; and

Perza was sworn into office as Councilman of the Second District on May 14, 2012 and served with distinction until May 11, 2015 and, during his three years of service to the citizens of Dover, Adam M.
