## DRAFT PROPOSED COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO. 2015-02

- BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DOVER, IN COUNCIL MET:
- That the Mayor and Council have determined that the Charter of the City of Dover should be amended to
- establish a police chief selection committee comprised of the mayor, council president, chair of the safety 5
- 6 advisory and transportation committee, city manager, and the human resources director. Therefore, the Mayor
- and Council of the City of Dover respectfully request the General Assembly of the State of Delaware to amend
- Article V Miscellaneous Provisions, Section 53 Police; Mayor to be conservator of peace, of its Charter,
- which amendments, if adopted by the General Assembly, would be as follows:

## ARTICLE V. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

- 11 Sec. 53. Police; mayor to be conservator of peace.
- 12 There shall be a city police force, the number thereof and their salaries shall be determined by the council, but
- they shall be chosen and appointed by the mayor. The mayor is hereby vested with all the powers of a
- conservator of the peace within the city limits. A police chief selection committee comprised of the mayor, 14
- council president, chair of the safety advisory and transportation committee, city manager, and human 15
- resources director shall advise the mayor on the nomination of the police chief. The mayor shall appoint 16
- nominate a chief of police, whose appointment shall be effective upon confirmation by the city council.
- 17 18 The chief of police shall be subject to removal at any time by the mayor, with the affirmative vote of two-
- thirds of the members elected to the city council, in accordance with applicable laws. The members of the 19
- police force shall be subject to his/her the direction and orders of the chief of police delivered through the
- 20
- proper chain of command and in accordance with applicable laws and ordinances. They shall preserve peace and 21
- 22 order, and compel obedience within the city limits to the ordinances of the city and the laws of the state. They
- 23 shall have such other duties as the council and the mayor and the city council shall prescribe by
- ordinance. 24
- Each member of the police force shall be vested with all the power and authority within the city limits and 25
- 26 within one mile outside of said limits, (and, in the case of the pursuit of an offender, without limit) of a constable
- 27 of Kent County.
