



COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO. 2013-14

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Dover have been greatly saddened by the death of Robert H. Tudor Sr., former Councilman and prominent businessman in the City, who passed away on April 13, 2013; and

WHEREAS, Robert H. Tudor Sr. served as Councilman of the Second District from August 10, 1981 to May 13, 1985 and from June 22, 1992 to May 13, 1996, and, during his years as a Councilman, served on the Utility Committee, the Building, Plumbing, Mechanical, and Fire Prevention Code Appeals Committee, the Parks and Recreation Committee, and as Liaison to Kent County; and

WHEREAS, Robert H. Tudor Sr. was an honorary member of Robbins Hose Company No. 1 and was instrumental in the financing and construction of Fire Station 2; contributed greatly to the Dover community as the owner of several local businesses; and devoted many years to the City of Dover as an outstanding Councilman, a good leader, and friend to the Mayor and Council and to the citizens of Dover; and


