2 **A RESOLUTION PROPOSING APRIL 15 - APRIL 26, 2013 AS SPRING CLEANUP WEEKS**

3 WHEREAS, we are fortunate to live in a City so abundantly blessed with natural assets and we have
4 a continuing responsibility for preserving our environment by keeping it clean, healthy, and beautiful; and

5 WHEREAS, the Annual Old Dover Days celebration, a period set aside to honor the heritage of the
6 City, will be celebrated May 3 - 5, 2013; and

7 WHEREAS, during this celebration we have the opportunity to demonstrate to ourselves, our
8 neighbors, and our visitors, our commitment to a clean and beautiful city.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
10 DOVER, IN COUNCIL MET:

11 1. That the weeks of April 15 - 26, 2013 are designated as SPRING CLEANUP WEEKS in the
12 City of Dover.

13 2. That all organized and individual segments of our population participate in this noble effort
14 by developing and carrying out imaginative clean-up, paint-up, and fix-up projects which will serve to
15 enhance, restore, or maintain the beauty of all properties in our community.

16 3. All Spring Cleanup debris should be placed for pickup along with regular household garbage
17 during the weeks of April 15 - 26, 2013 so that our City will exemplify cleanliness and beauty during the
18 Old Dover Days celebration.
