



**COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO. 2010-04**

1 WHEREAS, the City of Dover is entitled to \$296,526 through the United States Department of Housing and  
2 Urban Development Community Development Block Grant program; and

3 WHEREAS, the City of Dover has prepared the 2010-2014 Consolidated Plan, in accordance with the  
4 United States Department of Housing and Urban Development guidelines, that serve as the primary planning  
5 document for identifying and meeting the housing and community development needs for the low and  
6 moderate-income residents of Dover; and

7 WHEREAS, the City of Dover is in favor of utilizing the Community Development Block Grant funds for  
8 the community development purposes in accordance with the National Community Development objectives  
9 of benefitting low and moderate income families, eliminating slums and blight, and meeting other  
10 community development objectives; and

11 WHEREAS, the United State Department of Housing and Urban Development requires the City of Dover  
12 to submit a Consolidated Plan and an Action Plan for Application for Federal Assistance including the  
13 proposed use of funds and including certain certifications and policies to obtain its \$296,526 entitlement;  
14 and use of \$10,292 in program income for eligible activities; and

15 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
16 DOVER APPROVE THE 2010-2014 Community Development Block Grant Consolidated Plan and  
17 application for Federal Assistance included in the Consolidated Plan, along with certifications and policies  
18 attached and authorize its forwarding to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development  
19 for consideration.
