TOWN OF NEW HARTFORD, NY LOCAL LAW INTRODUCTORY "F" OF 2014

A LOCAL LAW TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF NEW HARTFORD, CHAPTER 118 THEREOF ENTITLED **ZONING** BY AMENDING ARTICLE XIV: ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS, SECTION 118-126 CREATION; APPOINTMENT; ORGANIZATION, TO REDUCE THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS.

BE IT ENACTED by the Town Board of the Town of New Hartford as follows:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> ARTICLE XIV, ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS, SECTION 118-126 CREATION; APPOINTMENTS; ORGANIZATION is hereby amended to read as follows:

A Zoning Board of Appeals is hereby created in accordance with Article 16 Section 26 of the Town Law. Said Board shall consist of <u>five</u> members appointed by the Town Board Members and shall be residents of the Town of New Hartford. The members of the current Zoning Board of Appeals shall be reduced to the extent that the two current members with terms first to expire shall be eliminated from said Board. Upon the expiration of the terms of the five remaining Board members, the Town Board shall by resolution, appoint or re-appoint members for a term of five years.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> All other provisions of Chapter 118-126 of the Code of the Town of New Hartford are hereby affirmed except to the extent that this Local Law shall modify or amend.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> This Local Law shall become effective immediately upon its filing in the Office of the Secretary of State.

TOWN OF NEW HARTFORD, NY LOCAL LAW INTRODUCTORY "G" OF 2014

A LOCAL LAW TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF NEW HARTFORD, CHAPTER 23 THEREOF ENTITLED **PLANNING BOARD**, BY AMENDING ARTICLE II: TOWN-WIDE PLANNING BOARD, SECTION 23.4 PURPOSE; MEMBERSHIP; ESTABLISHMENT, SUBSECTION B., TO REDUCE THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS.

BE IT ENACTED by the Town Board of the Town of New Hartford as follows:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> Chapter 23 ARTICLE II, Section 23-4.B of the Code of the Town of New Hartford, Title, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 23-4. Purpose; Membership; Establishment

B. The Town Board of New Hartford does by this Article create a Town-Wide Planning Board for the whole Town with a membership of five members. The membership of the current Planning Board shall be reduced to the extent that the two current members with terms first to expire shall be eliminated from said Board. Upon the expiration of the terms of the five remaining Board members, the Town Board shall, by Resolution, appoint or re-appoint members for a term of five years.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> All other provisions of Chapter 23 of the Code of the Town of New Hartford, and amendments thereto, are hereby affirmed except to the extent that this Local Law shall modify or amend.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> This Local Law shall become effective immediately upon its filing in the Office of the Secretary of State.
