The purpose of this correspondence is to comment, pursuant to the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA), on the above-referenced development project pending before the New Hartford Town Board. My comments will be limited to the projects potential impact on the delivery of police services to the development and the immediate area.

George T. Koury II is requesting a zoning amendment from Medium Density Residential (MDR) to High Density Residential (HDR) as same relates to approximately 6.5 acres located at 31 Clinton Road. After re-zoning, Mr. Koury would develop and construct a 4 building apartment complex with 6 units per building. Additionally, parking lots and driveways will serve the proposed development. This writer has reviewed the "calls of service" from three similar complexes on Clinton Road, Cardinal Estates, Lewiston Apartments and Swiss Garden Apartments to better understand the potential need for police services. Also, motor vehicle crash statistics were reviewed to determine service impacts.

For sewer extensions:

The proposed project is an extension of a municipal sanitary sewer system tributary to the Sauquoit Creek Pump Station owned and operated by Oneida County. Oneida County is under a Consent Order with DEC to bring overflows from the Sauquoit Creek Pump Station into compliance with the county's State Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (SPDES) Permit. Adding flow to this line results in the County having to reduce flows coming into the headworks from the Utica line during wet weather in order to protect the headworks. This in turn results in an increased discharge of untreated sewage from Utica's combined sewer overflows. This discharge of untreated sewage contributes to the Impairment of the Mohawk River, which is listed on the State's 303d list of Impaired waters.

We request that Lead Agency inform us of what provisions are being made to ensure that these increased sewage flows do not add to the frequency, magnitude and duration of Utica's combined sewer overflows."

In recent years, DEC has experienced periodic overloading of the Onelda County Sewer District's Sauquoit Creek Pumping Station. This has resulted in not only the discharge of untreated wastewater onto the surface of the ground and to the Mohawk River but in basement flooding in the villages of Whitesboro and Yorkville. LOCAL LAW INTRODUCTORY "B" OF 2014

A Local Law to amend the Code of the Town of New Hartford, Chapter 107B thereof entitled TELECOMMUNICATIONS FACILITIES in the Town of New Hartford.

BE IT ENACTED by the Town Board of the Town of New Hartford as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> Chapter 107B of the Code of the Town of New Hartford, Section 107B-5 is hereby amended by adding the following:

E. Collocated/existing structure antennas.

An antenna that is to be attached to an existing communications tower is a permitted use in all zoning districts. An antenna that is to be attached to any other structure in any zone, other than a residential zone or within 750 feet of a residential zone, is a permitted use. These antennas are permitted upon the issuance of a building permit. The building permit application will include a structural analysis/report verifying the ability of the structure to support the antenna while also deeming the structure to be capable of supporting the additional loads. The height of the antenna shall not extend above the height of the existing structure by more than 50 feet.

<u>Section 2.</u> All other provisions of Chapter 107B of the Code of the Town of New Hartford, and amendments thereto, are hereby affirmed except to the extent that this Local Law shall modify or amend.

<u>Section 3.</u> This Local Law shall become effective immediately upon its filing with the Office of Secretary of State.

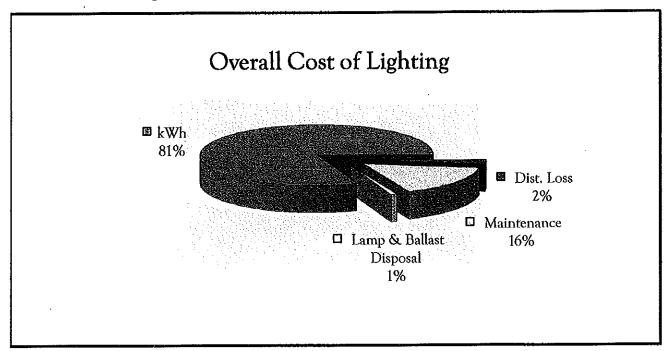
