END OF EXECUTIVE SESSION

Councilman Miscione then offered the following Resolution for adoption and Councilman Messa seconded same:

WHEREAS, Town Justice William Virkler has recommended the appointment of Jacqueline Warcup and Gertrude Pick to fill the existing vacancies of Court Clerks and has recommended their starting salaries;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the New Hartford Town Board does hereby confirm Town Justice Virkler's recommendation to fill Court Clerk vacancies and does hereby appoint Jacqueline Warcup for a 6-month interim period, commencing January 2, 2014 at an annual salary of \$30,000; and does further appoint Gertrude Pick for a 6-month interim period, commencing January 2, 2014 at an annual salary of \$24,000. Salaries shall be paid bi-weekly.

Of concern was whether the road met Town specifications and whether core samples should be mandated. This matter will be further discussed at the January 8, 2014 Town Board meeting.
