HOME OCCUPATION AGREEMENT

Home Occupations Defined (OMC 17.59)
A home occupation is any endeavor conducted for financial gain or profit in a dwelling unit. Home occupations may not be generally consistent with such structures or locations and should be limited to activities include the receipt of mail, the use of a telephone, and occasional commercial delivery of goods and materials, but only if they are consistent with normal vehicular traffic common to residential neighborhoods.
To qualify as a home occupation, the following limitations apply: (Initial each)
The home occupation will be entirely within a residence and operated by the residence occupants.
The home occupation will be clearly incidental to the use of the residence as a dwelling.
 The home occupation will not change the residential character of the dwelling. The home occupation will be conducted in such a manner as to not give any outward appearance nor manifest any characteristic of a business in the ordinary meaning of the term.
The home occupation will not infringe upon the right of the neighboring residents to enjoy a peaceful occupancy of their homes for which purpose the residential zone was created and primarily intended.
