

RESOLUTION NO. 89-01

A RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO ORDER THE IMPROVEMENT OF BROADWAY AVENUE BETWEEN SR 26 AND ELM STREET, AND BETWEEN MAIN STREET AND LEE ROAD BY PAVING, AND BY CONSTRUCTING CURBS AND GUTTERS, A WATER LINE AND A STORM DRAIN SYSTEM, AND FOR THE FORMATION OF A LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT TO PAY IN PART FOR SUCH IMPROVEMENTS

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the CITY OF OTHELLO, as follows:

That the City Council intends to order the improvement of Broadway Avenue between SR-26 and Elm Street and between Main Street and Lee Road by paving, and by constructing curbs, gutters, a water line and a storm drain system, and for the formation of a local improvement district to be paid in part by the levy and collection of assessments upon the property fronting said street improvements (excepting therefrom the real property commonly referred to as Adams County Tax Parcel Nos. 113, 153, and 245 lying on the east side of Broadway), and upon those properties specifically benefitting from said improvements. It is proposed that the water line be 10 inches in diameter upon which there will be installed fire hydrants at all other necessary attachments thereto attached which water line will run from the approximate location of Soda Street to SR 26.

All persons who may desire to object to any of the above may appear and present their objections at a public hearing to be held on April 10, 1989, at 8:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as can be heard at the regular meeting of the Othello City Council in the City Council Chambers at the Othello City Hall, 512 East Main Street, Othello, Washington.
