



DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE

Project Name: Olympia Utility Extension

Description of Proposal: Address capacity deficiencies in Othello's sanitary sewer and storm sewer collection system to accommodate future development by extending sanitary and storm sewer main in Olympia Street right-of-way and future alignment from 7th Avenue west to Broadway. Storm sewer main will also be extended within Broadway from the Olympia alignment south to Fir Street.

The project includes trenching to a maximum depth of 15' to install approximately 2700' of 12" to 18" sanitary main and 4100' of 12" to 24" storm main. Portions of the work will be within developed right-of-way and portions will be in undeveloped future right-of-way.

Proponent: City of Othello

Location: Starting at the intersection of 7th Avenue and Olympia Street, west to Broadway, then south to Fir Street. Olympia Street bisects S34-T16N-R29E east to west, and 7th Avenue bisects the section north to south. Broadway is located on the section line between Sections 33 & 34, T16N-R29E.

Lead Agency: City of Othello

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c). This decision was made after review of a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the lead agency. This information is available to the public on request.
