Two Marysville Residents Injured in Sunday Roll-Over Crash

On March 25, 2018, at approximately 7:58 am, the Union County Sheriff's Office received a 9-1-1 call reporting a possible injury crash in the 22000 block of Bearswamp Road in Liberty Township. Deputies and units from the Liberty Township Fire Department and the Allen Township Fire Department responded to the scene and found a 1997 Honda Civic that had been driven off the right side of the road and into a ditch. The vehicle rolled multiple times before coming to rest in a field. The driver has been identified as Brian M. Spaulding, age 21 of Marysville. He sustained injuries in the crash and was transported to Memorial Hospital and later transferred by Medflight to the Ohio State University Wexner Medical Center. The passenger in the vehicle, Setimio J. Signoracci age 21 of Marysville, was ejected from the vehicle and sustained serious injuries. He was flown from the scene by a Medflight helicopter to the Ohio State University Wexner Medical Center. The preliminary investigation has revealed that excessive speed and alcohol are believed to be contributing factors in the crash.

The crash remains under investigation by the Sheriff's Office and the Multi County Crash Investigation Team (MCCIT).
