

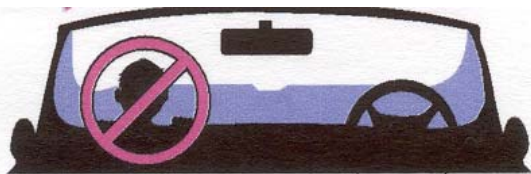

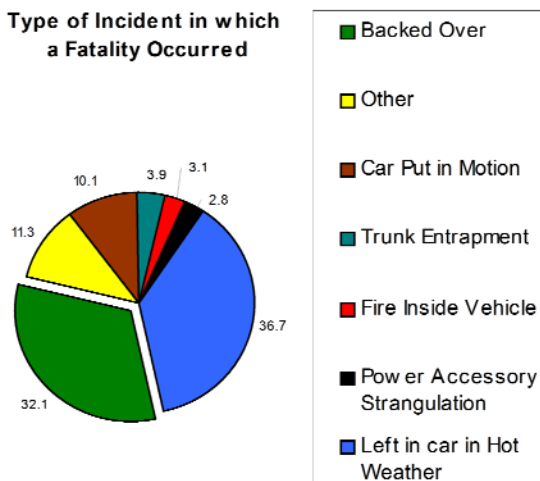

STATISTICS

Lots of caring and responsible parents have left their children alone in or around a car, not realizing the risks involved. Some parents think it is okay to leave a child alone in a car while they run into a store, quickly drop off dry cleaning or while dropping off another child at school. The dangers are real. The results of leaving a child unattended in or around a vehicle can be deadly.

Type of Incident in which a Fatality Occurred



DANGERS!

A child can;

put a vehicle
in motion,



suffer heat stroke in a
hot vehicle,

activate power accessories
and become trapped in
power windows or
sunroofs,

turn on the ignition,

and become trapped
in trunks!

Watch Out!

Children don't know
vehicles are dangerous!

Check around your
vehicle before moving it!



Safety Tips

- Never leave children alone in a vehicle.
- Keep vehicles locked at all times, even in the driveway or garage.
- Never leave keys where a child can get them.
- Inspect around your vehicle before moving it.
- When a child is missing, check vehicles and car trunks immediately.
- Teach your children not to play in or near vehicles.

If a child is locked in a vehicle, call 911 for help. If they are hot or seem sick, call 911!
