

STATISTICS

Lots of caring and responsible parents have left their children alone in or around a car, not realizing the risks involved. Some parents think it is okay to leave a child alone in a car while they run into a store, quickly drop off dry cleaning or while dropping off another child at school. The dangers are real. Safety Tips

- When a child is missing, check vehicles and car trunks immediately.
- Teach your children not to play in or near vehicles.

If a child is locked in a vehicle, call 911 for help. If they are hot or seem sick, call 911!
