



It is hereby certified that on the 7th day of August 1875. I made a survey and division into lots, streets & alleys of the following described lands to be known as Cranston's second Addition to Broadway. Union County Ohio Beginning at a stone northwesterly corner to Cranston's first addition to Broadway. thence with the West line of Walnut Street S 47° E 25 poles to a stake. Thence S 43° W. 21 poles to a stake. Thence N 47° W 27 poles to the south line of the A & G. W. Railway lands. Thence with said line N 43° E to the westerly line of Survey N: 829. Thence with said line S 8 1/4° W. 3 1/2 poles to a stake. Thence N 43° E. about 1 1/2 poles to the beginning containing 3 Acres and 87 poles. Part of Survey N: 829 and 5641 ac.
