## Plat of Blaiborne Union Co. Ohio.

I hereby certify that on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of March T.D. 1881, I surveyed and divided for William Jolliff Jr. the following described lands into streets and alleys to be known as the town of Blaiborne.

## Description -----

In Blaiborne Township, Union Co. Ohio, being a part of Survey No 6107. Beginning at a stone in the center of the Bassady Road and in the south margin of the lands of the N.Y. and O.R.R. thence (True meridian courses) S 46 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 504 feet to a stake. thence S 84 $\frac{1}{4}$  E 300 ft. to a stake, thence S 12 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 270 feet to a stake in the Styr lands. thence S 78 $\frac{1}{2}$  E 150 feet to the center of the Richwood <sup>by</sup> Bokes Creek Gravel Road, thence with the center of said road N 12 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 489 ft. to a stone, in an angle of said road. thence with the center of said road S 84 $\frac{1}{4}$  E 260 ft. to a stake thence S 12 $\frac{1}{2}$  E 139 feet to a stake, thence S 84 $\frac{1}{4}$  E. 416 feet to a stone, thence N 5 $\frac{1}{2}$  E 273 ft. to a stone, thence N 84 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 636 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet to a stake. thence N 12 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 656 feet crossing the N.Y. <sup>by</sup> O.R.R. thence S 77 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 136 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet to the center of the Bassidy road. thence with the center of said road. S 12 $\frac{1}{2}$  E 465 ft to the place of Beginning. containing 10 $\frac{3}{4}$  Acres of land excepting therefrom the grounds of the N.Y. and O.R.R. included in the description being a strip 100 feet wide as shown on the plat also lots No. 1-3-4-30-37 containing 1 $\frac{3}{4}$  Acres. the amount hereby laid out into lots being 9 acres. the size of lots, streets and alleys are marked in feet upon the adjoining plat.






