Essex Plat A plat of the Town of Essex Located by
 John Cheney proprietor of Union County Jackson
 Township and State of Ohio Situate on Mush Creek
 and being part of Survey No 9922 of entry Virginia
 Military Lands and lying on the State Road leading
 from Columbus to Kenton, Lots Streets and Alleys
 compose the Plat. Lots are all five rods each in width from north to south
 and eight rods from East to West each containing one quarter of an
 acre the Streets are four poles wide each the alleys are one pole in
 width the lots are known and designated by numbers Beginning on the
 South western corner of said Plat thence counting the next lot on the
 East No 2 thence alternately up the Western tier of said lots as is seen
 by inspection and counting the two Eastern tiers of Lots from north to
 South in like manner The Beginning Corner Witnessed by a Stone
 placed permanently in the ground is in the Southeast corner of lot
 No 1 the directions of the Streets from the South is north 20 West and
 those from East to West are at right angles thereto as for names of the
