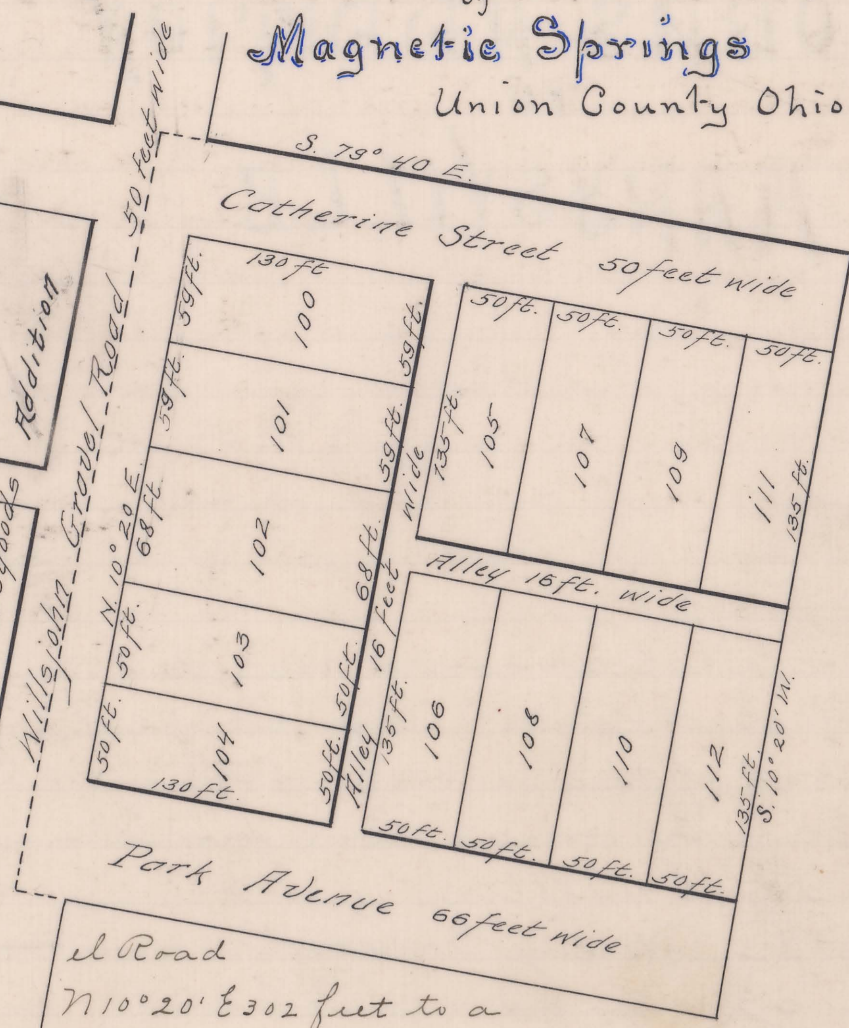


Plat of Hoskins'

Union County Ohio.



It is hereby certified that on the 6th day of May 1881, I made a survey and division into lots, streets and alleys of the following described lands to be known as Hoskins' Addition to the Town of Magnetic Springs Union County Ohio. Being part of Survey N^o 3696. Beginning at a stone, tile and brick in the east line of the Mills John Gravel Road and the north line of Catherine Street of said town. Thence with said line S 79° 40' E 346 feet to a stake. Thence S 10° 20' W 302 feet to a stake. Thence N 79° 40' W 371 feet to a stake in the center of the said Mills John Gravel Road. Thence with the center of said Road stake. Thence S 79° 40' E 25 feet to the beginning. containing 2 acres and 91 poles.

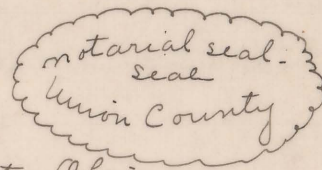
