To the Hon. the Board of Commissioners of Union County and State of Ohio.

We the undersigned inhabitants and qualified voters of the said County of Union & within the territory hereinafter described do hereby make our petition according to law for the purpose of being incorporated as a Village under the name and style of Milford Center.

The territory to be included in said Village is described as follows To wit (See plat accompanying this petition) Beginning at a stake in the center of the road from Milford to Bellefontaine and north west corner to Maria J. Harberts land Thence with the center of said road N 84° W 2¹/₂⁵ poles to a stake. Thence N 16° E. about 87 pole. crossing the Mill dam and along the west line of R. D. Reeds Grove to the south side of a County Road. Thence S 71° E. (with southerly edge of said road) 96⁶⁰/₁₀₀ to a gate post near R. D. Reeds house at the forks of the road and north side of Reed Street. Thence with the north side of said street S 62¹/₂° E. 82⁶⁸/₁₀₀ poles to a point 50 feet N 62¹/₂° W. from the center of the L. C. & R. R. Springfield Branch. Thence N 38¹/₂° E. parallel with said Railroad and 50 feet therefrom 60 poles to a stake. Thence S 56° E. crossing Rail Road & with the north line of Samuel Snodgrass' lot and crossing Milford & Marysville Road 35 poles to a stake. Thence S 31¹/₄° W 87¹/₂° poles (passing 2 large & 1 small sycamore from Root at 79¹/₂ poles. to the center of Big Darby Creek. Thence down said Creek to the lower corner on the Creek to Martha Evans lot. Thence with the lost line of said lot S 21¹/₄° W 28 poles to the center of the Milford & Pleasant valley road. Thence with the center of said road N 71° W 9.60 poles to a stake northeast corner to Dr. E. H. Walden's lot. & north west corner to Edward Spain. Thence with the west line of said Spain S 19° W 69¹/₂ poles to a stake in the center of the Columbus and Indianapolis Rail Road. Thence same course 50 feet to the south line of said Rail Road. Thence westerly with said line of said Rail Road. to the center of the Milford & Springfield road. Thence with said road S 33 W 54⁴⁰/₁₀₀ poles to a stake, S. E. corner to John Deans lot. Thence with the south line of said Deans lot N 56° W. 42.56 poles to a stake (2 pole S 56° E. from center of track of the L. C. & R. R. Springfield Branch) Thence N 22¹/₄° E. 51.25 poles to a stake in the west line of the Battle Pens. and 45 feet southerly from the center of track of the Columbus & Indianapolis Railroad. Thence westerly with the south line of said Rail Road. 101 poles. to the westerly line of the Jacob Fairfield farm. Thence N 14° E. with the west line of Reeds Addition to Milford & west line of Maria J. Harberts lot 70 poles to the beginning
